Musician, 49, killed in car crash

Former Music Mania band leader Malcolm Higgins has died.

On July 7 Mr. Higgins, 49, was involved in a single vehicle crash at Meadowvale Road and Hwy. 401. He died 10 days later at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre surrounded by his family.

Along with being a part of Music Mania from 2000 to 2003, Mr. Higgins, a paralegal and former Toronto police officer, was lead

singer for a variety of AC/DC tribute bands.

Mr. Higgins is survived by daughters Alyshia, 24, Heather, 22, sons Kenny, 20, and Paul, 18, and wife Ivy, whom he had been separated from since 2004.
