The FL Button Trophy is sponsored each year by local law firm Button, Armstrong and Ness in memory of Eric Button's grandfather, FL Button who was a lawyer in Whitchurch-Stouffville.

The trophy was created by FL's son, Reg Button, who also practised law here. Because he liked hearing loons at his cottage, there is a loon motif.

When Reg was a boy, he was among a group of youngsters on decorated bicycles who escorted then-Prime Minister Mackenzie King into Stouffville in 1927 to present a trophy for a lawn bowling tournament at the green.

Stouffville race team sixth in Edmonton NASCAR race

Jason Hathaway drove the Stouffville-based EHR/Team 3 Red's Snap-on Tools/Vortex Brake Pads Dodge to a sixth-place finish in the 2010 NASCAR Canadian Tire Series' Canadian Tire 100 race presented by Konica Minolta in Edmonton Sunday.

Through qualifications, Hathaway started the 32-lap race

on the Edmonton City Centre Airport temporary 1.973-mile, 14-turn road course in the 10th position.

Running a fairly consistent race, Hathaway felt he could have improved his standing were it not for a driver who almost took him out of the race during the final lap.

"It is pretty frustrating when a non-regular competitor wants to race to you into a corner and doesn't know better than to lift," Hathaway said. "I had fun racing him all day long, but the last lap of the race was pretty crazy. I had to back out of the corner to make sure the guy didn't take me out.

"In the end, NASCAR saw the incident and we came out on top. The crew worked great this weekend and our road course program got a huge boost."

J.R. Fitzpatrick took the checkered flag.

The result by Hathaway atoned for a disappointing 22nd place finish they encountered at the recent Jumpstart 100 race that was a support event during the Toronto Honda Indy.

The next event on the NASCAR Canadian Tire series circuit is on the oval in Vernon, B.C., today and then the Auto Clearing Motorspeedway in Saskatoon Aug. 4.

In the overall drivers standings, Hathaway occupies sixth place with 675 points. Fitzpatrick leads the series with 839 points.
