Spirit making move to Sunday matinees

In the case of the Stouffville Spirit, they had been seeking a change in their home game dates to play more Sunday matinees at the Stouffville Arena.

While the club's lobbying efforts were unsuccessful in the past, their wishes finally came to fruition when the Ontario Junior A Hockey League recently announced their regular season schedule and divisional alignments for the 2010-11 campaign.

This season, the Spirit will host 17 Sunday afternoon tilts.

The first of which will take place with their home opener against the Burlington Cougars Sept. 12 at 2:10 p.m.

Recollecting the occasions when they played home games in the past on Sunday afternoons, club management sensed it attracted more spectators and heightened enthusiasm as compared with their traditional Thursday evening tilts.

Spirit general manager Ken Burrows was elated when the league accomodated their request.

"We tried to have our home games changed for the last three years," he said. "We think that playing on Sunday afternoons is for the better (when arranging their home schedule for the upcoming year)."

The Spirit will still play some home games on Thursday evenings - six to be exact.

The first (matinee) will take place with their home opener against the Burlington Cougars
Sept. 12 at 2:10 p.m.

As well, they will host one Monday contest. That being an Oct. 11 Thanksgiving Day matinee game against the Markham Waxers at 2 p.m.

Playing a 50-game regular season schedule, the Spirit will be part of the league's North West Conference's North Division.

Joining the Spirit in that group are the Aurora Tigers, Colling-

wood Blues, Huntsville Otters, Newmarket Hurricanes, Orangeville Crushers and Markham Waxers.

While the Spirit will play games against their divisional rivals, they will also face teams from the conference's West Division.

Those entries include Burlington, Brampton Capitals, Buffalo Junior Sabres, Georgetown Raiders, Hamilton Red Wings, Mississauga Chargers and Oakville Blades.

As a part of their regular season schedule, the Spirit will also play two games in the league's annual Governors Showcase weekend in Aurora Oct. 7 to 11.

The Spirit will play Hamilton Oct. 9 at 7:30 p.m. and Aurora Oct. 10 at 2:30 p.m.

The Spirit are slated to open the regular season in Huntsville Sept. 10 at 7:30 p.m.

In gearing up for the regular season, the Spirit will commence training camp Aug. 15 with fitness testing at BodySmith International in Gormley.

On-ice practices at Stouffville Arena will commence Aug. 16.

The Spirit will open their pre-


season schedule with back-to-back tilts against the Markham Waxers Aug. 19 at the Stouffville Arena and the following day at Markham Centennial Arena. Both games are slated to start at 7:30 p.m.

The Spirit will then host St. Michael's Buzzers Aug. 26 at 7:30 p.m. before travelling to Huntsville Aug. 27 to 29 to take part in the Cottage Cup tournament.

While in Huntsville, the Spirit are slated to play four games.

The Spirit will conclude preseason play at St. Michael's Sept. 2 at 7:30 p.m.


