Coach of OMHA champs dies

Steven Wright had a passion for the game of hockey and was rewarded for his efforts as a volunteer with the Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association after coaching the Stouffville peewee AE Clippers team to the coveted Ontario Minor Hockey Association title last spring.

With a new minor hockey season just around the corner, the 50-year-old Stouffville resident's love for the game will be sorely missed as he passed away at home last weekend.

He is survived by his wife Andrea and their children Tyler and Dana.

Mr. Wright was involved in the association for more than seven years starting as a volunteer coach in the mites and tykes program. In following years, he served in various capacities as a head and assistant coach, recalled Greg Smith, association second vice-president rep program.

"The Stouffville hockey community lost a great person, and a very dedicated volunteer in Steve Wright," Smith said. "He loved the game of hockey, and the competitive aspect it represented."

What impressed Smith most about Wright's coaching skills was

his ability to ensure each player was treated fairly and with respect and given an opportunity to chip in.

This was evident last season when Wright's club was the only Stouffville team to win an OMHA crown.

"Steve felt that each and every kid should be able to make a contribution, and he went to great lengths to ensure all his players were treated fairly and equitably," said Smith.

"In the run to the OMHA championship last season, Steve made sure every player was given equal opportunity to be part of the fun and the competitive challenge. He rolled his lines in each game, and when the final horn blew, and the team had won the OMHA championship, every kid on the ice knew that they had played an equally important part.

"These kids will remember this for the rest of their lives, and the

experience was made better because of the life lessons Steve helped them learn. Lessons like how to truly be a team, how to respect each other and the competition, and how to strive to reach your goals. They may not realize it now, but some day they will."

Smith was also quick to point out Wright didn't mince his words, but always did it with a high degree of diplomacy.

"Steve was very articulate, and was not afraid to provide his opinion on what he thought was right," he said. "I might not have agreed with him all the time, but he would continue to question, in an assertive, yet respectful way. And it was always about what he thought was best for all kids involved, and not just his son, or a smaller group of players.

"I think anyone involved with hockey in Stouffville, and who really knew Steve, will miss his passion to make things better for all the kids, and the game itself in this town.

"His passing is a loss on many levels for Stouffville."

A funeral service will take place today at 11 a.m. at Highland Funeral Home, Markham Chapel, 10 Cachet Woods Ct. (northeast carrier of Hwy. 404 and 16th Ave.)
