## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS AUGUST 17, 2010

### YORK REGION CRIME RATE DOWN



York Regional Police Superintendent Stan Colley from 1 District and Superintendent Robertson Rouse from 5 District presented Council with an update regarding crime in York Region and more specifically Stouffville. From a 2010 Stouffville Survey the "Top 5 Community Concerns" were Crimes against Property, Traffic Safety, Crime Prevention, Guns & Gangs, and Drug Control & Enforcement. With the crime rate down almost 7%, York Region is still one of Canada's safest communities.

### MUSSELMAN'S LAKE PARK PURCHASE APPROVED

Council approved clearing its Conditions on the Offer of Purchase & Sale Agreement to acquire lands from the James Coultice Estate for a park and open space. The acquisition of this site for park and related purposes achieves a significant number of the "attributes" that have been referenced by the residents in their desire to have a park constructed within The Community of Musselman's Lake. Staff will embark upon the next phase of the workplan, being the design of the park in consultation with the Community in 2011. Staff will also continue discussions with the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority concerning the potential transfer of the Open Space lands to their ownership for longterm protection, restoration and enhancement.

### BALLANTRAE TENNIS COURTS FACELIFT

Council approved the resurfacing of the existing 2 tennis courts in Ballantrae and the construction of 2 additional tennis courts.

### WATER SUPPLY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE COMMUNITY OF STOUFFVILLE

The Region of York has completed the commissioning process for the supply of lake based drinking water to the Community of Stouffville. As part of York Region's Long Term Water Supply initiative to provide a secure water supply to the Community of Stouffville, the groundwater supply is being supplemented with lake-based water from the York Water System (YWS). The YWS has been implemented by connection to a new pump station located at the North Markham Reservoir on McCowan Road just south of Stouffville Road and water supply is being conveyed through a watermain on Stouffville Road to the existing system.

### HOOVER PARK DRIVE AT TENTH LINE TO BE CLOSED AUGUST 16th to 26th

### MANTLE AVE AT TENTH LINE TO BE CLOSED AUGUST 27th to SEPTEMBER 6th

Decorative pedestrian crossings are planned for the intersections of Tenth Line and Hoover Park Dr, and Tenth Line and Mantle Ave. To facilitate construction of the coloured impressed concrete, each lane must be closed for about 8-10 days. To avoid conflicts in the new traffic circle the side streets must be closed.

Hoover Park Dr will be closed at the Tenth Line from Aug 16 to Aug 26, and Mantle Ave will be closed at the Tenth Line from Aug 27 to Sep 6; subject to weather conditions. Temporary traffic signals will be in place on Tenth Line to allow one-way traffic through the circles.

Please consider an alternate route and exercise caution if you do travel through the construction area. The Town appreciates your patience as construction on the Tenth Line nears completion.
