Still time to fight cancer at police golf tournament

York Regional Police will be fighting cancer instead of crime Monday.

Chief Armand LaBarge and the police service's Clubs4Cancer Committee have invited residents of York Region to join them at the tournament.

This is the third year for the fundraiser, which has raised \$50,000 for the Southlake Regional Health Cancer Centre in Newmarket and \$20,000 for the Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre in Toronto.

"So many of us have been touched by this disease and this is an opportunity to raise funds for cancer research," said spokesperson Sgt. Gary Phillips.

Registration begins at 7 a.m., with a shotgun tee-off at 7:45.

A barbecue lunch will be served, followed by a live auction hosted by CTV Toronto sports director Lance Brown.

All proceeds will go to the Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre and the Markham Stouffville Hospital cancer unit.
