Mobility Plus will have a public information centre open at the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park in Stouffvillle Thursday from 7 to 9 p.m.

Mobility Plus is York Region's door-to-door accessible public transit service for people with disabilities.

The drop-in centre will provide information on eligibility requirements, which are determined on a case-by-case basis and not on any particular disability, income level or lack of accessible public transit.

Registered users of the service can book trips that will take them anywhere within York Region, seven days a week.

Mobility Plus can even connect riders to Durham, Peel and Toronto's accessible transit services.

Other drop-in centres will be held across the region in Newmarket (Sept. 14, town hall, council chambers), Richmond Hill (Sept. 21, town hall, council chambers) and York Region (Sept. 28, administrative centre, seminar room).

All centres are open from 7 to 9 p.m.


