
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
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COMING UP: Holiday shopping at Ninteen on Park

Crafty Christmas show helps artists, gallery

That perfect Christmas gift can't always be found on the shelves of a big box retailer.

Sometimes, those wow factor presents come from artisans. And to give people a head start on their holiday shopping this year, the Beyond Craft Show and Sale will take place Nov. 11 to 14 at the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park.

"It's like a mini One-of-A-Kind" show, said Jennie Creeggan, a potter and the show's coordinator.

Along with pottery, people will find items made from glass and metal, along with jewelry, specialty chocolates, handmade soaps and textiles.

"One stop and you have access to about 30 different artists' work," Ms Creeggan said.

Some of the returning artisans include Sharon Maude (textiles), Katrina Covello (stain glass and jewelry) and Brooks Chocolates, who will be joined by newcomers Kingston Soap, Monique vanWel (jeweler) and Stouffville's Sarah Porter (glass and jewelry).


Ms Porter has always been fascinated by the arts, but in particular jewelry after she received her first wooden bead necklace as a baby.

"After having brief affairs over the past 10 years with leather work, painting and stained glass, I took a simple jewelry stringing course and it was then that I found true love," according to Ms Porter.

Beyond Craft is a juried show and sale that not only highlights artisans from all over Ontario, but it is also a fundraiser for the Latcham Gallery.

Last year, the show raised \$5,500. This year, organizers want to raise \$8,000 for the gallery.
