



POLICE: Foggy, election-night crash

Run over by own vehicle, man still in intensive care

A Stouffville man remains in intensive care at St. Michael's Hospital after he was run over by his own vehicle last month.

Shortly before midnight on municipal election day, Oct. 25, James Olive, 31, was standing in front of his Ford Ranger pickup truck, which was parked on the south shoulder of Hwy. 47, just east of the York Durham Line and north of Stouffville.

An eastbound Chevy Silverado, driven by a 43-year-old Uxbridge man, hit the back of Mr. Olive's truck, causing it to roll over him.

The driver of the second pickup truck was travelling around the speed limit, which is 80 km/h in that area, according to Det. Const. Dave Ashfield of Durham Regional Police.

Mr. Olive was rushed to Uxbridge hospital before being airlifted to the Toronto trauma centre with life-threatening injuries.

There was heavy fog in the area at the time and alcohol was not a factor, according to Det. Const. Ashfield.

New \$72M digs for York officers

A \$72.5-million York Regional Police building that will house several specialized units opened in Aurora yesterday.

Officers assigned to homicide, traffic, sexual assault, forensic identification, canine, air support and emergency response will call the building home.

A customer service counter for screening those interested in working with vulnerable people and volunteering and a new forensics lab will also be inside the facility at 47 Don Hillock Dr., in the Wellington and Leslie streets area.

York police plan to move about 450 staff into the LEED silver-standard facility before the end of this year, York police Chief Armand La Barge has said. The building will replace three facilities the force has leased around the region.

Police headquarters will remain at the administration centre on Yonge Street in Newmarket.

The region will own the new building and the land on which it is built.
