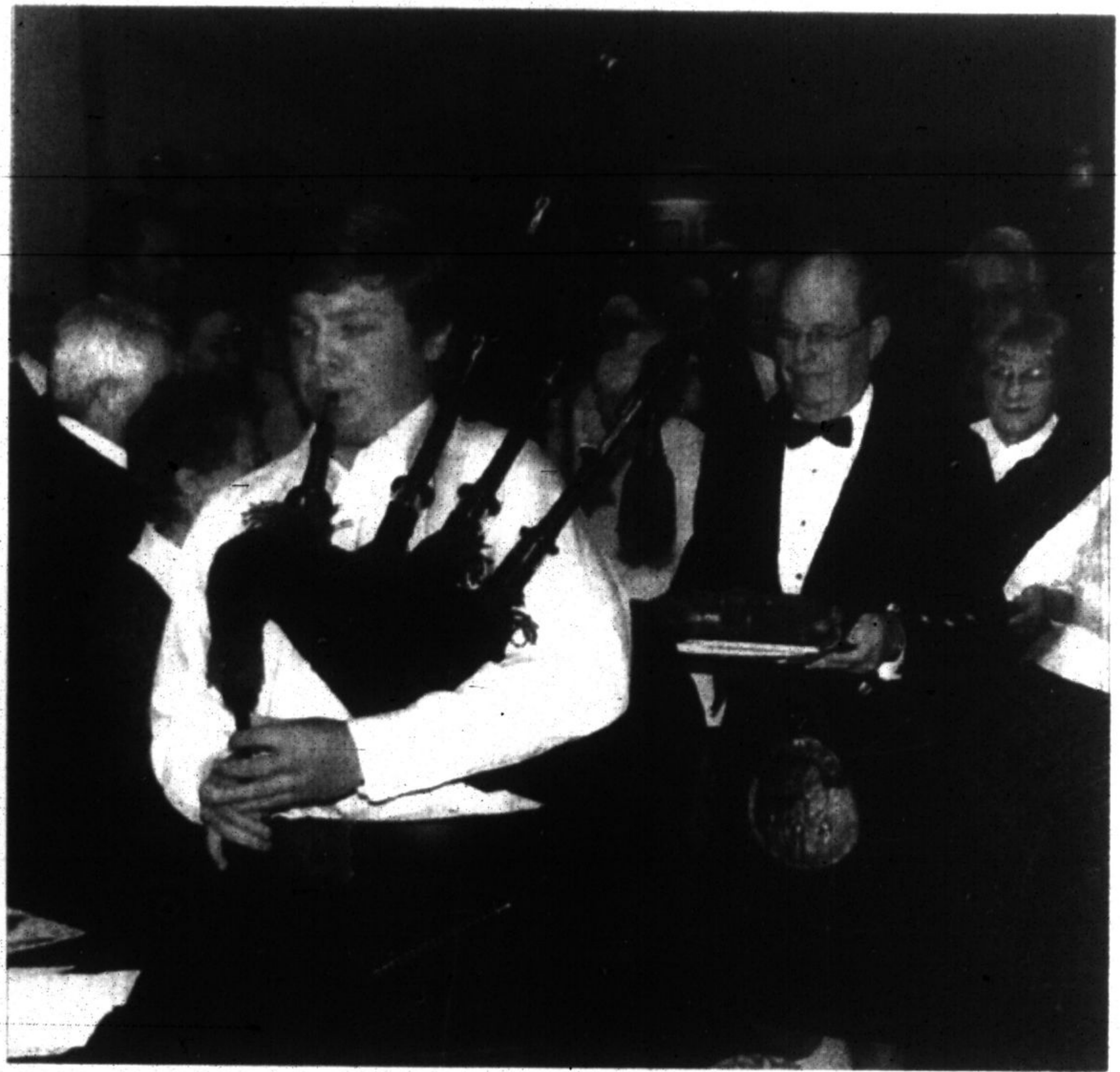

**COMING UP: SUM concert series**

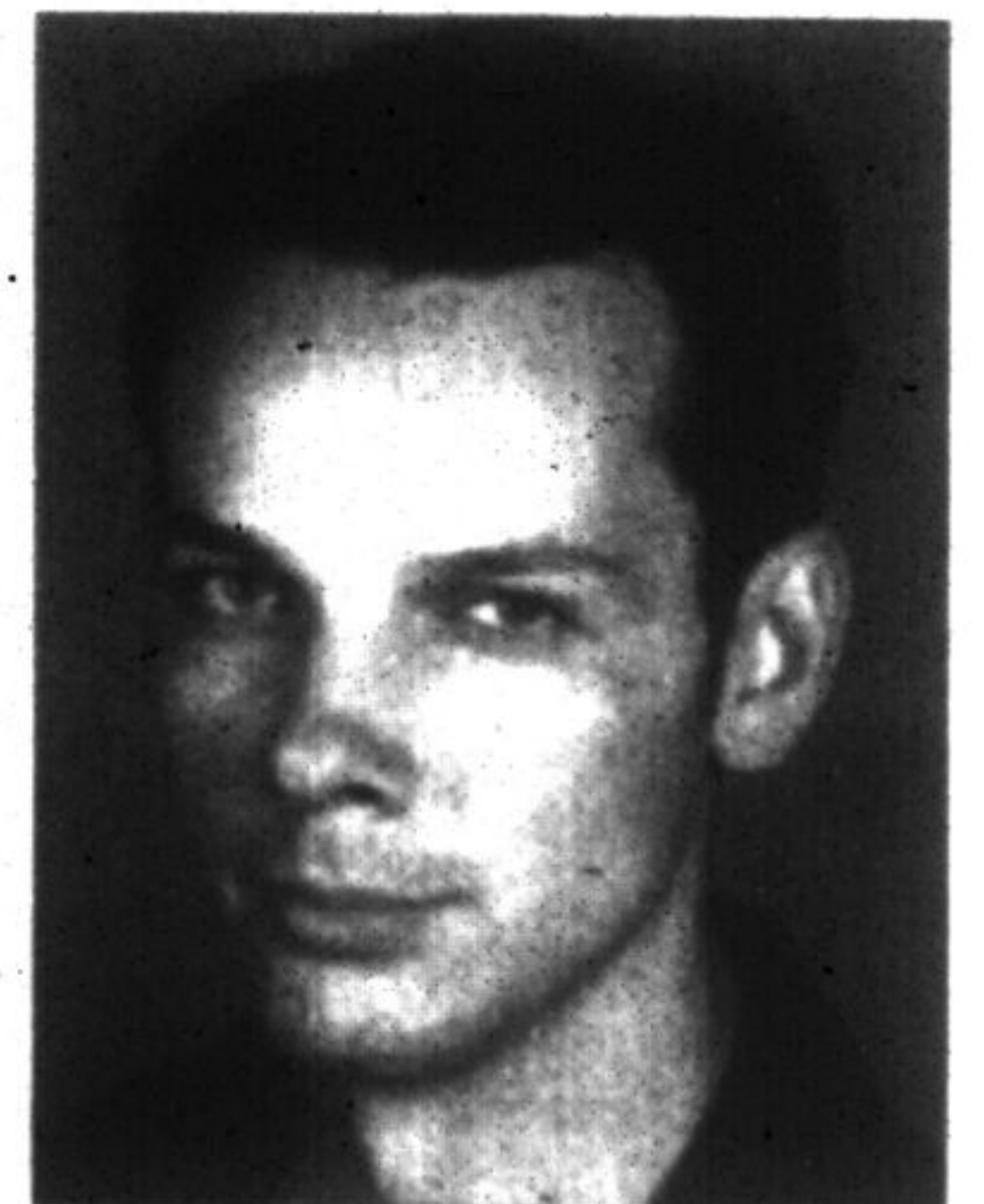
**Silent era back in town
