"I love the stories of songs. ... It helps you to appreciate the song," Mr. Gordon said.


Some of Mr. Moore's inspiration includes his own questioning of how much he loves Christ and his unworthiness of God's love.

One of his hymns - I'm Depending on You, Lord! - was written one Sunday morning while Mr. Moore and his wife, Esther, were driving to Toronto, where he was to lead a service.

"(I was) taking the opportunity to whisper a prayer. I said: 'Lord, I'm depending on you for this service today.' Without realizing it, I began to sing the words," wrote Mr. Moore in his book My Songs and Their Stories. "That was the first time I had ever composed a chorus while driving a
