#### Pierson set for UFC in Toronto

For Sean Pierson, it's now official.

The 34-year-old Stouffville resident and mixed martial arts competitor will be a part of the undercard for the upcoming UFC 129 event to take place at the Rogers Centre in Toronto April 30.

At a news conference held Tuesday in Toronto to introduce the competitors, it was announced Pierson will compete in his second UFC welterweight match against Brian Foster, 26, of Sallisaw, Oklahoma.

"It's a dream come true and I'm honoured to be a part of it," Pierson said.

While Pierson had heard rumours he would be a part of the UFC 129 card late last year, he did not get the official word until about three weeks ago.

"I was told I would be on the card because

I'm a local fighter, but no promises had been made. I was sitting there waiting and hoping and it eventually came true," he said.

Pierson acknowledged he will have his hands full. But he feels they have similar fighting styles.

Pierson sports an 11-4-0 record while Foster is 17-5-0.

"He usually finishes his fights quickly." Pierson said. "And he might have a little more UFC experience than what I have and he's younger.

"But we'll see what happens.

"Right now I'm back to training and putting a game plan together."

The card will be headlined by UFC welterweight and Montreal native Georges St-Pierre battling Jake Shields of San Fran-CISCO.
