LOAD RESTRICTIONS

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING

DECEMBER 1st TO MARCH 31st INCLUSIVE

Parking rules ensure that our streets are clear to accommodate traffic flow, emergency vehicles and snowplows.

Parking is prohibited on Town streets between 2:00 am and 6:00 am.

Vehicles parked on the street during this period will receive a fine of \$ 50.00.

Please do not park so as to interfere with snow plowing; cars parked on town streets that have not yet been serviced may be subject to a fine.

Do not park in such a manner to cause a vehicle to overhang onto the roadway or the sidewalk.

WINTER REMINDERS

To assist the Public Works Department with its winter maintenance activities residents are reminded of the following

- 1) Do not to push snow from driveways on to the travel portion of the road.
- 2) When driving, stay well back of snow plows as they are, on occasion, required to back-up during plowing operations.
- 3) Do not to allow children to play on snow piles located on or at the side of the roads. Snow plow operators may not see children playing in the snow.
- 4) **The municipality is not responsible for damage to items placed on Town Property, by property owners. Examples of such items are fences, posts, hedges, shrubs, concrete and wood driveway curbs. Removal of these items will aid in our road and sidewalk plowing operations and prevent damage to these property improvements.**

RECYCLING COLLECTION REMINDER

Residents are reminded that blue box recycling materials will be collected only in a molded rigid open top container not exceeding 65cm (26 inches) in length, 50cm (20 inches) in width and 50cm (20 inches) in height.

Cardboard broken down to 90cm x 90cm x 30cm (36"x36"x12") dimensions, newspaper and boxboard bundled and tied can be placed next to the blue box for collection to provide more volume in your blue box.

Containers not accepted for collection include:

- containers including contents weighing over 22kg (50 pounds)
- oversized (approx 128 litre) containers with wheels and lid which are sold at some local improvement stores. The overall weight, size and durability of these containers prevent safe and effective collection.
- plastic bags
- cardboard boxes
- do not cover the container with a net or lid
