TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER

Council were informed by staff of a Rogers Communications Inc. telecommunications tower proposed to be located at 3151 St. John's Sideroad. The regulation and approval of telecommunication towers and related facilities is under Federal jurisdiction and assigned to Industry Canada to coordinate. Town protocol requires the proponent to consult with surrounding landowners and public agencies. A community meeting was hosted by Rogers at the Ballantrae Community Centre on March 2nd, 2011. Any written submissions made to the Town concerning the Proposed telecommunications tower will be provided to Rogers Communications Inc. as a component of their reporting practices to Industry Canada.

FOLLOW UP COMMUNITY SURVEY

Council endorsed the use of DPRA Canada Inc. to conduct the upcoming Community Survey.
