Some lights will remain on in and around some town facilities due to safety concerns.

The first Earth Hour took place in Sydney. Australia March 31, 2007 after WWF Australia began looking at ways to take climate change mainstream.

More than 2.2 million residents and 2,100 businesses participated.

The following year, 371 municipalities, including Whitchurch-Stouffville, in more than 35 countries went dark March 29 between 8 and 9 p.m. local time. Earth Hour organizers estimate between 50 and 100 million people participated.

In 2009, more than 4,000 cities in 88 countries participated and last year, 128 countries and territories flipped the switch to 'off' for the hour.

In 2010, more than 1,000 of the world's man-made and natural wonders also went dark, including the Eiffel Tower, Empire State Building, Niagara Falls and Buckingham Palace.

Earth Hour is a symbolic action, not an energy/carbon reduction exercise.

"Earth Hour aims to showcase the possibilities of a united global effort by creating an inspiring visual display of the worldwide resolution to address global warming," according to Earth Hour organizers. "Earth Hour asks everyone to take personal accountability for their impact on the planet and make behavioural changes to facilitate a sustainable lifestyle."


