Driver killed after SUV strikes trailer

A 64-year-old Vaughan woman died yesterday after the SUV she was driving hit a trailer being pulled by a pickup truck in Whitchurch-Stouffville.

At about 8:40 a.m. the westbound silver Mercedes SUV crossed the centre line on Bloomington Road, just east of Ninth Line, and struck a trailer that was being towed by a 34-year-old Oshawa man operating a red Ford truck.

A Honda Civic following the truck struck the rear of the trailer.

The female driver died at the scene. Neither the driver of the pickup truck nor the 30-year-old North York man operating the Honda Civic were injured.

"It has happened in the past - it turns out it was the result of a medical condition. We don't know," said Const. Rebecca Boyd of York Regional Police, who noted the investigation is continuing.
