

Emmerson talking business

When it comes to local businesses, what is the town doing to attract new companies, while maintaining the ones already here?

On Monday, Mayor Wayne Emmerson will address this issue, along with other matters on the minds of the local business community, at a dinner being presented by the Whitchurch-Stouffville Chamber of Commerce.

"We're especially pleased that (Mayor Emmerson) is willing to open the floor to questions and I think that is where we are going to get some real dialogue," said Mardi Taylor, executive director of the chamber.

The event takes place at the Meadowbrook Golf and Country Club, 11939 Warden Ave., and includes networking, as well as dinner.

"Anyone with an interest is more than welcome to attend," Ms Taylor said.

Although chamber members have indicated to Ms Taylor that businesses are doing quite well, the question now is how do they attract new residents who may still be more comfortable shopping in their former areas.

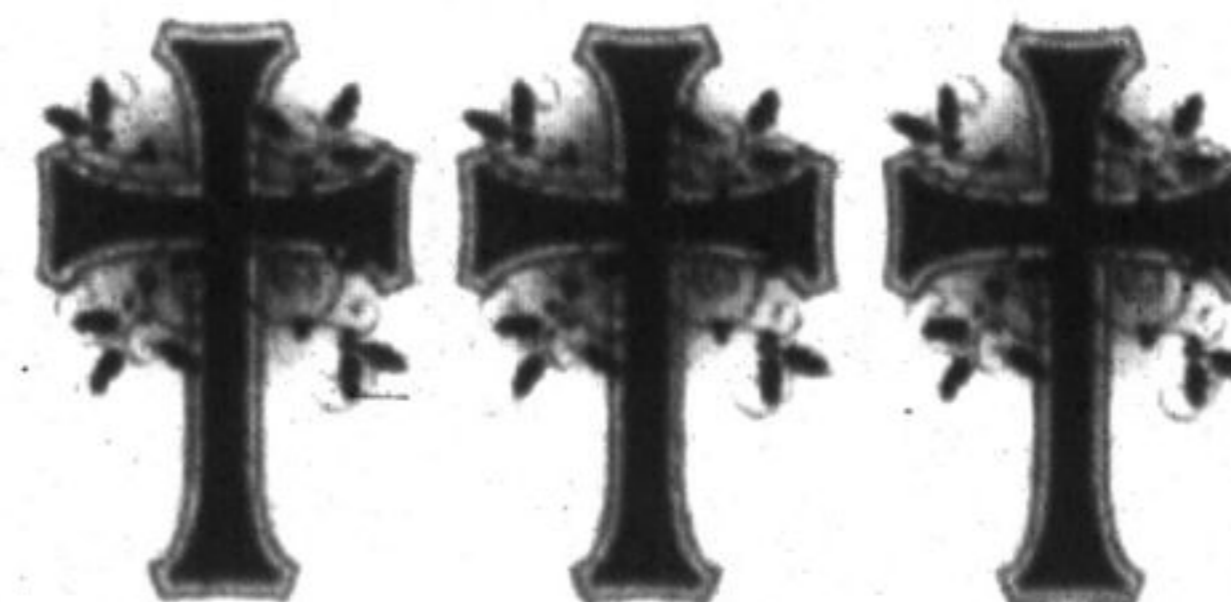
