Although chamber members have indicated to Ms Taylor that businesses are doing quite well, the question now is how do they attract new residents who may still be more comfortable shopping in their former areas.


"How can we make them feel at home in our community ... and then want to start accessing the businesses here, break the habit," Ms Taylor said.


The Business Community dinner starts at 5 p.m. with networking, followed by dinner at 6:30 and the mayor's speech.


