Spartans remain hot

When the Stouffville District Secondary School senior boys' rugby team took part in the Red Hot Tournament it paid off in more ways than one.

For starters, the Spartans won their division title, which was capped off with a resounding 41-17 win over Sir Wilfrid Laurier (Scarborough) in Sunday's final on the St. Joan of Arc Catholic High School pitch Sunday.

At the same time though, the Spartans came up with what they feel will be their starting roster for the remainder of the season, which they hope will lead them to a defence of their York Region Athletic Associations title and an Ontario Federation of School Athletic Associations gold medal.

With the Spartans cruising to victory in the final and their semifinal tilt, which produced a 31-0 thrashing of Fenelon Falls earlier in the day, head coach Jamie Hewitt said he was able to tinker with various lineup combinations.

In the final game, Curtis Crago, Paul Geiger, Pat Laffan, Lofthouse, Nick McEwan, Kevin DeVogel and Theron Coetse each scored one try. James McLeod booted two converts and Kurt Batty, one.

Against Fenelon Falls, Crago recorded two tries while Geiger, Scott Miller and Laffan each had one. McLeod booted three converts.

As for his club's performance in the tournament, Hewitt was pleased, especially since he feels his club can adapt to whatever style of game the opposition elects to try and implement.


That doesn't bode well for any opponents that will face the Spartans for the rest of the season.

"We played well," he said. "Our forwards and backs played well. Everything is coming together. We can play a fast game or a physical game because our forwards are big and strong. That will be hard for anyone to defend."


