

# Coffee house performers sing for hospital climbers, kids

Seventeen Markham Stouffville Hospital supporters, including physicians and people from the community, will embark on a nine-day climb of Mount Kilimanjaro in July.

All 17 have pledged to raise \$10,000 each, with a goal of \$50,000 to go towards the expansion of the hospital's child and adolescent mental health wing and to "fight the stigma against mental health" said Rachel Peters, who is co-ordinating a fundraiser to help children affected by mental illness.

Ms Peters is a 21-year-old longtime Stouffville resident inspired by the need of support for children with mental illness.

She is co-ordinating a local Coffee House Cafe fundraiser at Christ Church Anglican June 3 to raise money and support for the climbers.

"I really wanted to do something in the community to bring it to attention," she said.
