Terry Fox Run honouring cancer survivors

Organizers of the 2010 Terry Fox Run in Whitchurch-Stouffville wanted to raise \$100,000 for cancer research.

They surpassed that number and maintained their place as the community raising the fifth highest total in Ontario out of 220 communities for the third straight year.

Last September's event in south Stouffville brought in \$114,500. A few days later, local students raised

another \$22,540 on national school run day.

"This is such a giving town," said local run co-ordinator Sandy Schell Kennedy. "People care and they want to help others."

It's not a town immune from cancer.

This year's run - Sept. 18 from the Lebovic Leisure Centre - will

honour Whitchurch-Stouffville's cancer survivors.

"Many of our neighbours know cancer first hand," said Mrs. Schell Kennedy. "We want to celebrate our survivors, as well as remembering our other loved ones."

Survivors, identifying themselves to organizers in advance of the run, will be outfitted with commemorative red T-shirts.




