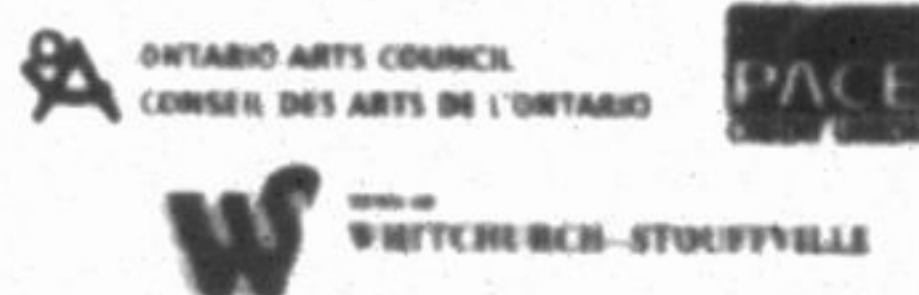

Kids can learn to cycle safely at village

Signal training, obstacle avoidance, gearing and rules of the road are just some of the skills young cyclists will learn during this year's Kids CAN-BIKE York Region Bikefest.

The free two-hour training session takes place at the York Region Community Safety Village in Bruce's Mill Conservation Area, 3291 Stouffville Rd., June 4.

The event is open to children seven to 13 years of age. Cyclists must bring their own helmets and their bikes have to be in working order.

Parents are asked to register their children by calling 1-877-464-9675, ext. 1581.

There are three sessions available: 9 a.m.,

11 a.m. and 1 p.m. Participants need to arrive 30 minutes early to allow for a bike tune-up.

The CAN-BIKE cycling safety program is the Canadian Cycling Association's nationally standardized cycling safety program, which provides instruction on all aspects of safe cycling on the road.

It provides a standardized set of courses that can be taught through a variety of organizations interested in education, safety and health.

York Region's safe cycling training program aims to deliver the CAN-BIKE safe cycling program to 2,000 elementary school age students by 2012.

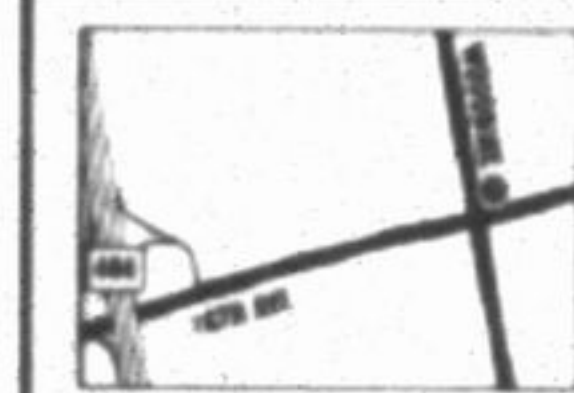

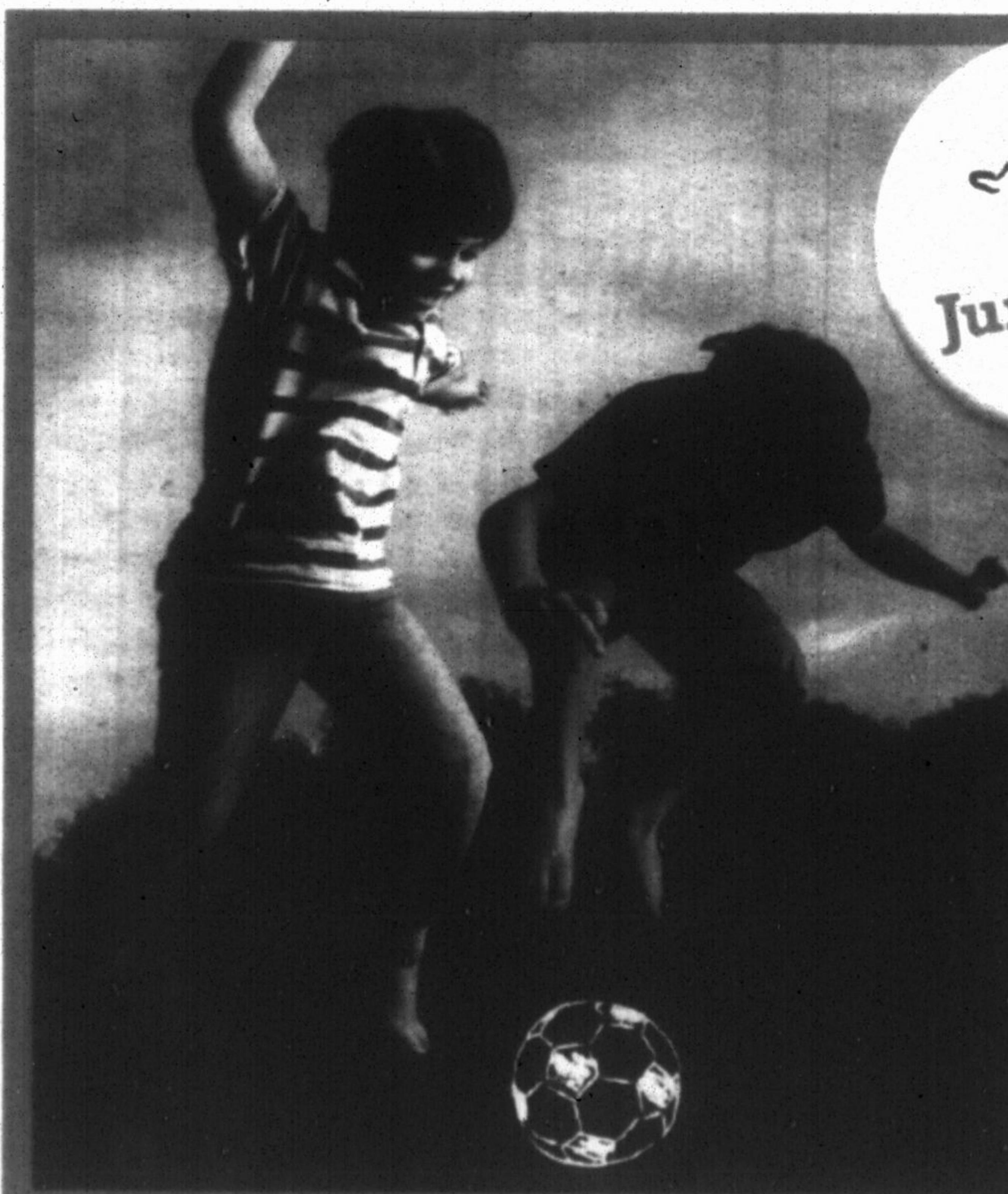
