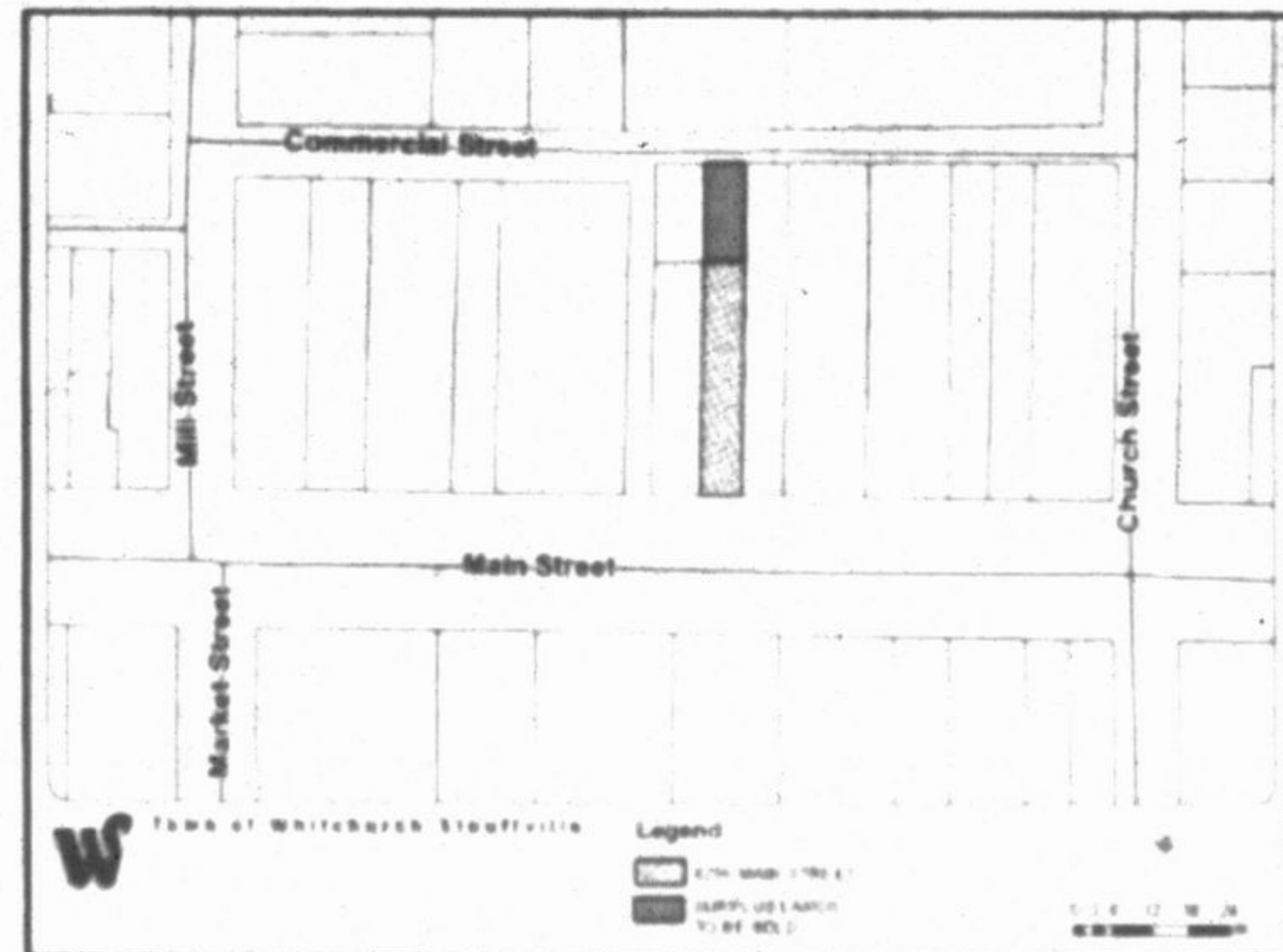

Proposed Streetscape Improvements
Main Street, Ninth Line to Pine Street**

A Public Open House / Information Meeting is being hosted by the Downtown Stouffville Working Group (DSWG) through the Physical Improvement & Design Sub-Committee to discuss proposed streetscape improvements to Main Street, from the Ninth Line to Pine Street.

The streetscape improvements proposed along Main Street deal with concepts associated with curb extensions, pedestrian crosswalks and other traffic calming designs. The overall objective of the streetscape improvements is to reinforce and enhance the pedestrian scale of development within the Downtown Core and the east / west approaches into the Downtown.

The format is a drop-in session where interested members of the Public can review drawings and discuss ideas / issues on a one to one basis with Town Staff and members of the Physical Improvement & Design Sub-Committee. There is no formal presentation, and, no decisions will be made that evening. Comments received through the consultation process will be used to refine the proposed streetscape improvements.

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE
HAWTHORN AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION**

Council has awarded a contract to Esposito Bros. Construction Ltd. to reconstruct Hawthorn Avenue from Tindale Road to Stouffer Street. The work is scheduled to commence in June and be completed by August 2011, weather permitting. The work includes installation of storm sewers together with curbs and gutters to replace the existing overland ditch drainage system, new asphalt pavement, and the replacement of existing sewer and watermain. A sidewalk will also be provided on the south side of the street.

During construction the road will be open for local traffic only. Please consider an alternate route and exercise caution if you do travel through the construction area.

DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS**

Please be advised that in accordance with the Weed Control Act, noxious weeds or weed seeds are required to be destroyed by June 15 and as required throughout spring and summer. In addition, please note that the Town's Weed Inspector may destroy any noxious weeds/weed seeds as required, the cost of which may be applied to the owner's property tax. Although dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds in the Town, the co-operation of all residents to eliminate these nuisance weeds is appreciated.
