

gone wild," she said. "Sometimes Ed buys a piece of furniture because he likes the pulls on it and then I have to deal with the furniture."

But Mrs. Casella has learned to make the most of her husband's hobby by transforming some of his vintage and antique keys and pulls into actual jewelry that she wears.

Mr. Casella's clients range from the hobbyist to professional furniture refinisher, to homeowners who want to maintain authenticity.

"I don't buy (a piece) with the intent of making a lot of money. I do it with the intent of replacing someone's lost pieces," Mr. Casella said. "You're going to get that one person who really cares and that's the person I'm interested in helping."

When Mr. Casella started his collection, he wasn't as astute in determining the difference between an original and a reproduction and he admittedly made a few mistakes along the

Mr. Casella also doesn't always realize when he has a real gem on his hands.

Last spring, Mr. Casella bought a lock box at the Aberfoyle Antique Market just because he liked it.

His grandchildren routinely played with it by locking and unlocking the box that would have been used on municipal buildings, such as town halls or libraries.

A locksmith Mr. Casella was working with e-mailed a photo of the box to the owner of a lock museum in the United States who indicated it was a very rare piece because of the amount of detail on it.

Along with Ed's Hardware, which is located behind the James Lemon House at 13924 Kennedy Rd., other properties open for viewing during Doors Open include 6108 Main St., which was built circa 1877 for John and Rachel Sanders, grain and coal dealers.

What makes this home unique is its Mansard-style roof on the front and side of the home. A Mansard roof is a four-sided gambrelstyle hip roof characterized by two slopes on each of its sides with the lower slope at a steeper angle than the upper punctured by dormer windows to create additional living space.

Another property being showcased is the Walter J. Smith Fire Station 5-1, on Weldon Road, which opened in 2009.


"People think that it has to be an old building or old house. But it can also represent a group. The fire brigade has been around since 1898." Ms Rauchenstein said.
