

Mennos no-hit in Oshawa

The Stouffville Mennos' bats went silent in their Oshawa City and District Fastball League contest against the host Oshawa Rebels Wednesday.

In fact, the Mennos failed to generate one hit against the Rebels' pitching tandem of Brian Mather and John Sharpe as they suffered a 6-0 loss.

The Mennos did, however, have opportunities to score as they had six batters reach base through walks and errors.

The Mennos' best scoring chance came in the second inning when they loaded the bases.

But Shawn Boadway ended the threat when he grounded out to short to end any potential uprising.

The Rebels scored four runs in their half of the second inning against rookie lefty Bruce Cringan, who made his starting debut for the Mennos.

The Rebels added their final two runs in the third inning off Cringan before he gave way to Greg Dalgarno, who finished the game.

In failing to generate a hit, the Mennos saw their team batting average fall to .188.

Now 3-5 on the season, the Mennos are scheduled to resume league play Tuesday in Scarborough against the Athletics. They host the Oshawa Rebels Thursday at 8:30 p.m. in Memorial Park.

Sadekar 10th at CN women's tour golf event

Seema Sadekar finished in a fourway tie for 10th place at the 2011 CN Canadian Women's Tour at Club de golf Beloeil event in Beloeil, Que., Wednesday.

Through the two-round event played on the par 71, 6,164-yard course, the 25-year-old former Stouffville resident carded a fourover 146 (72-74).

Sadekar finished eight shots off the pace set by Katy Harris of Humble, Tex., who was four-under par at 138.

Through two events on the tour, Sadekar was in a two-way tie for fifth place among the top-10 money leaders with earnings of \$6,689.89.
