**Are you odd?
... or even?**

Water conservation is everyone's responsibility. During the hot, dry weather, water conservation is required to ensure a sufficient supply of water is available for emergency services.

Summer outdoor water use bylaws are in effect across York Region.

Here's what you can do!

Follow your local outdoor water use bylaw. If your house number is odd, water on odd numbered days. If it is even, water only on even numbered days. Remember, water your lawn once each week at most and only if there has not been sufficient rainfall (1.5 to 2.5 centimetres) within the past week.
