She was born in Bay Roberts on February 21, 1921, the first daughter of eleven children of Bethlehem and Sophie Mercer.

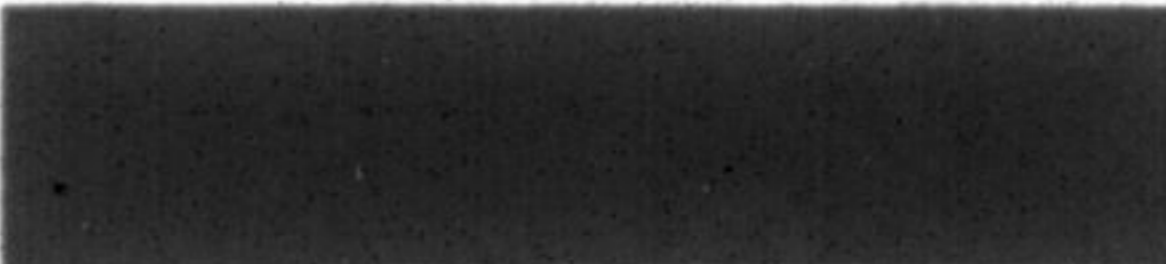
