# Lindsay, York dancers stay alive

Joey Arrigo and Shane Simpson landed back in the bottom three couples on So You Think You Can Dance Canada Tuesday night, along with Geisha Chin of Richmond Hill.

The two men made their first appearances in the bottom last week. This was Ms Chin's third time.

But the three York Region dancers vying to be named Canada's Favourite Dancer, survived their solo performances for the judges and will return next week.

The contest is down to 12 Canadian dancers, half of whom are from York. The other local dancers are Adam LoPapa (Woodbridge), Lindsay Leuschner (Stouffville) and Melissa Mitro (Richmond Hill).

Following Mr. Simpson's solo, judge

Jean Marc Genereux gave him a standing ovation. Mr. Arrigo's performance also got most of the judges on their feet.

"How are you not voting for him?" asked show host Leah Miller, adding Mr. Arrigo's solo gave her goosebumps and made her hair stand on end.

"You are just one of the most gorgeous dancers," she said.

The bottom three couples were determined through audience votes following Monday night's performance show. The

judges made the final decision following solo performances from each of the dancers.

Carlena Britch, a 20-year-old hip-hop and locking dancer from Vancouver, and 19-year-old Montreal hip-hopper JP Dubé were sent home.

The show airs Mondays and Tuesdays at 8 p.m. on CTV.
