# Young junior mite squad reaches Ontario title game

The Stouffville Storm advanced to the final of the 2011 Junior Mite boys provincial softball tournament before coming out on the short end of a 14-1 decision against Belleville in Stouffville Memorial Park Sunday.

Returning just one player from last year's team, the Storm lost their opening game to Cobourg 17-11 Saturday before rebounding to edge Napanee 11-8.

Returning to the ball diamond the following day, the Storm battled Belleville to an 11-11 draw.

That enabled the Storm to advance to the gold-medal game.

Cobourg claimed the bronze medal.

A weekend excursion to Niagara-on-the-Lake turned out to be a memorable outing for the Stouffville Storm squirt softball team.

Taking to the ball diamond for the Ontario Amateur Softball Association tournament, the Storm captured the B title after downing Springbrook 11-7 in Sunday's championship final.

Nic Fadden ignited the Storm offence with a home run and single while Tyler Ribi contributed a triple and single.

Anthony Messina and Jake Dilley each belted triples.

Matt Eizenga and Chandler Gloyns each contributed two singles while Brent Menzies and Jordan Stewart-Kuppek had one apiece.

Also handling starting pitching duties, Eizenga surrendered six hits and three walks while striking out seven batters to earn the win.

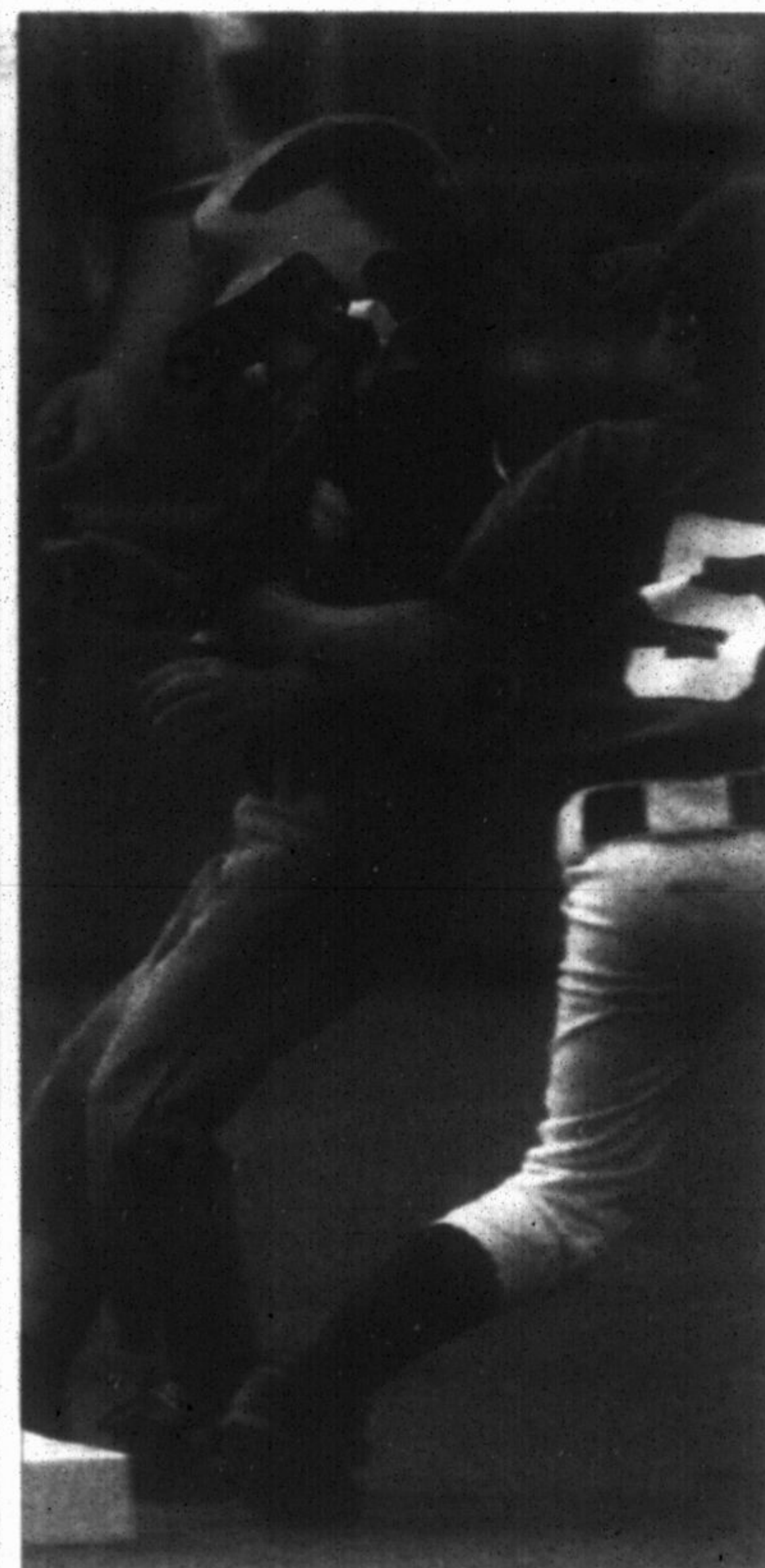
Catcher Brent Menzies was awarded the game ball for his continuing excellence in defense play.
