Cheek swab clinic for cop Saturday

Stouffville resident and Toronto Police Det.-Sgt. Tony Coscarella, 43, last fall was diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia.

His best hope for a donor was his younger sister, but she was not a match.

Now, he is appealing to the community, especially the Italian population, for a match and cheek swab clinic Saturday at Vellore Village Community Centre, 1 Villa Royale Ave., in Woodbridge from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Hundreds of Canadians are in need of transplants every year. A wide variety of diseases and disorders such as specific forms of cancer like leukemia, lymphomas or myelomas, or those who have inherited immune system and metabolic disorders can be effectively treated through stem cell

transplants.

Recognizing the need for more awareness on this pressing issue, OneMatch established a stem cell and marrow network dedicated to recruiting healthy, committed volunteer donors for patients in need of stem cells.
