

Child soldier speaks at Free the Children golf event

Former child soldier Michel Chikwanine, a speaker for Toronto-based global charity Free The Children, addressed the crowd at the Driving Change charity golf tournament at Rolling Hills Golf Club in Gormley Saturday.

Mr. Chikwanine grew up in the Democratic Republic of Congo amid the terror of the Great War of Africa and witnessed the rape of his mother and the torture of his father, who was singled out for his political beliefs. He also endured torture of his own.

Today, he addresses audiences across North America and has shared the stage with Free The Children founders Craig and Marc Kielburger, Dr. Jane Goodall, Robert F. Kennedy Jr., The Dalai Lama and former U.S. vice-president Al Gore.

The event raised \$10,500 for the Pareto School Pride Program and its upcoming mission to Kenya's Masai Mara region.
