

May busy with Majors, Sportsnet, skate show

The Mississauga-St. Michael's Majors added Brad May to their coaching staff for the 2011-12 Ontario Hockey League season Tuesday.

The 39-year-old Stouffville native will serve as an assistant coach to general manager and head coach James Boyd.

With commitments to appear on CBC TV's *Battle of the Blades* and as an analyst with Rogers Sportsnet and the NHL Network, May's duties with the Majors will include assisting with on-ice practices and serving as a spotter for games he's able to attend.

It's May's first season serving as an assistant coach. Last season, he was an analyst with CBC on their American Hockey League games and on TSN.

A 22-year veteran of the National Hockey League, May began his pro career as a member of the Buffalo Sabres and ended it 2009-10 with the Detroit Red Wings.

May logged time on five other teams including the Vancouver Canucks, Phoenix Coyotes, Colorado Avalanche, Toronto Maple Leafs and the Anaheim Ducks when they won the Stanley Cup in 2007.

Prior to making the jump to the NHL, May spent three seasons with the OHL's Niagara Falls Thunder, which are now the Erie Otters. He was a first-round pick of Buffalo, 14th overall in the 1990 NHL draft.

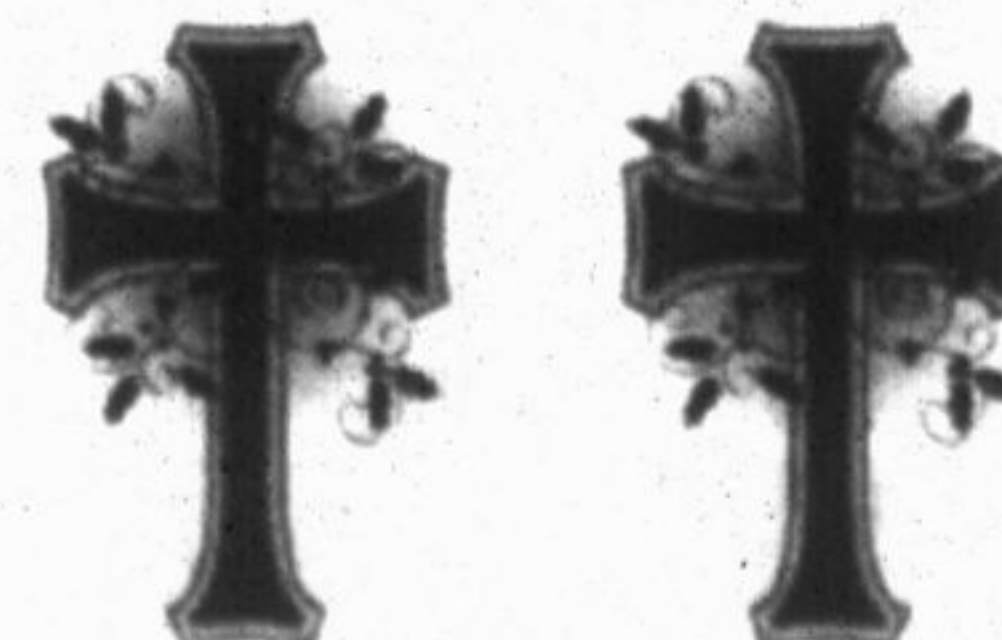
