TAXES ON NEWLY-CONSTRUCTED HOMES

Owners of newly-constructed homes may receive tax bills on the vacant lot only until the home is assessed by Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC). Once assessed, the owner will be issued a supplementary tax bill that will be retroactive to the date the home was purchased or occupied. Tax bills will be issued within the next few weeks for "Notice of Supplementary or Omitted Assessments" that have been recently issued by MPAC.

It may take up to three years for a newly constructed home to be assessed, so RESIDENTS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO BUDGET FOR THIS UPCOMING TAX BILL. To estimate the annual property taxes, multiply the purchase price by 1%. To set up a Pre-Authorized Payment Plan or submit a pre-payment towards this future tax bill, please contact the Town at 905-640-1900 or 1-855-642-TOWN (8696).


