Mr. Ramdail said.

The No. 9 route currently travels north and south along Ninth Line between Millard Street and the hospital.

Route No. 15 travels along Hoover Park Drive, Main Street, Hwy. 48, Tenth Line and Sam's Way.

The proposed change calls for the

route to be called No. 9 and all current areas, except for the Eastern Gate loop on the east end and another portion just south of Main Street along Ninth Line be eliminated.

York Region council will vote on the proposal.

The earliest the changes could be instituted is February.
