


Anti-politician after youth vote

Ruida Lu doesn't expect to win the MPP's seat in Oak Ridges-Markham, but he hopes to motivate the younger generation to cast a ballot and let all constituents know voting independent is an option.

The 20-year-old Oak Ridges resident threw his hat into the political ring because he is frustrated by the government's lack of transparency.

"I can't stand those politicians. I don't consider myself a politician. I'm a concerned citizen running for office," the third year York University Schulich School of Business student said before he took part in his first all-candidates meeting Saturday afternoon in Markham.


Mr. Lu said he chose to run as an independent because he does not care about political party interests.

He wants to represent the riding and said having to also answer to a party "is a limitation".

Mr. Lu's platform includes lowering hydro bills, eliminating the HST on everything, rolling back post-secondary tuition to the 2001 level and only adjusting it at the rate of inflation or deflation afterwards.

Mr. Lu, if elected, will also make gas

prices in the GTA more on par with prices in Buffalo, which he says are 25 to 30-per cent lower.

Mr. Lu's platform also includes banning new developments on the Oak Ridges Moraine and stopping the construction of the Pickering airport.

He supports full-day kindergarten in, Ontario.

"We need someone who cares about the community and puts the community first," he said.
