Mr. Bateman, 82, is a known environmentalist and he will be making a special presentation regarding the environment during his appearance, which takes place from 1 to 5 p.m.

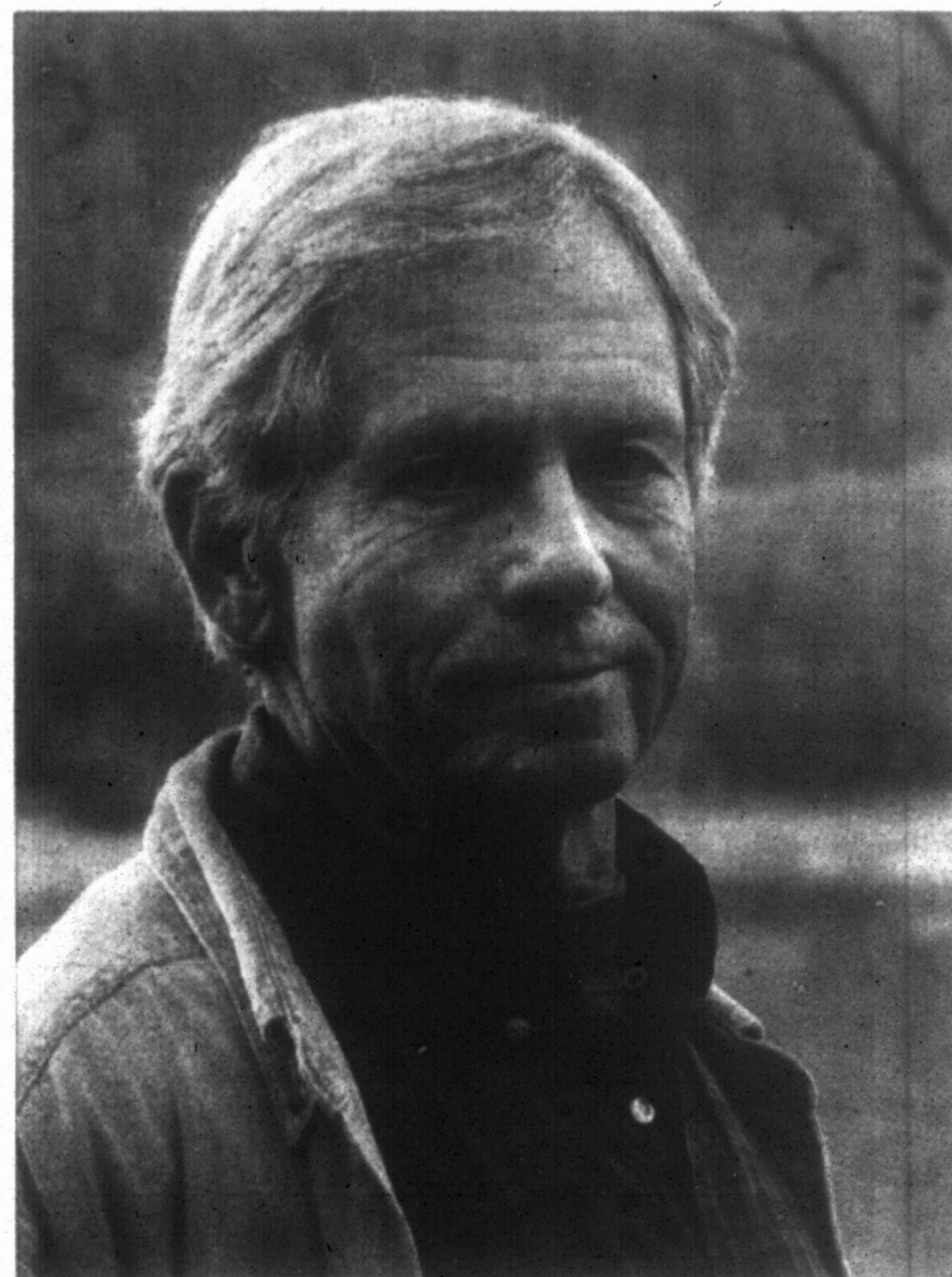
He will also autograph art work during that time.

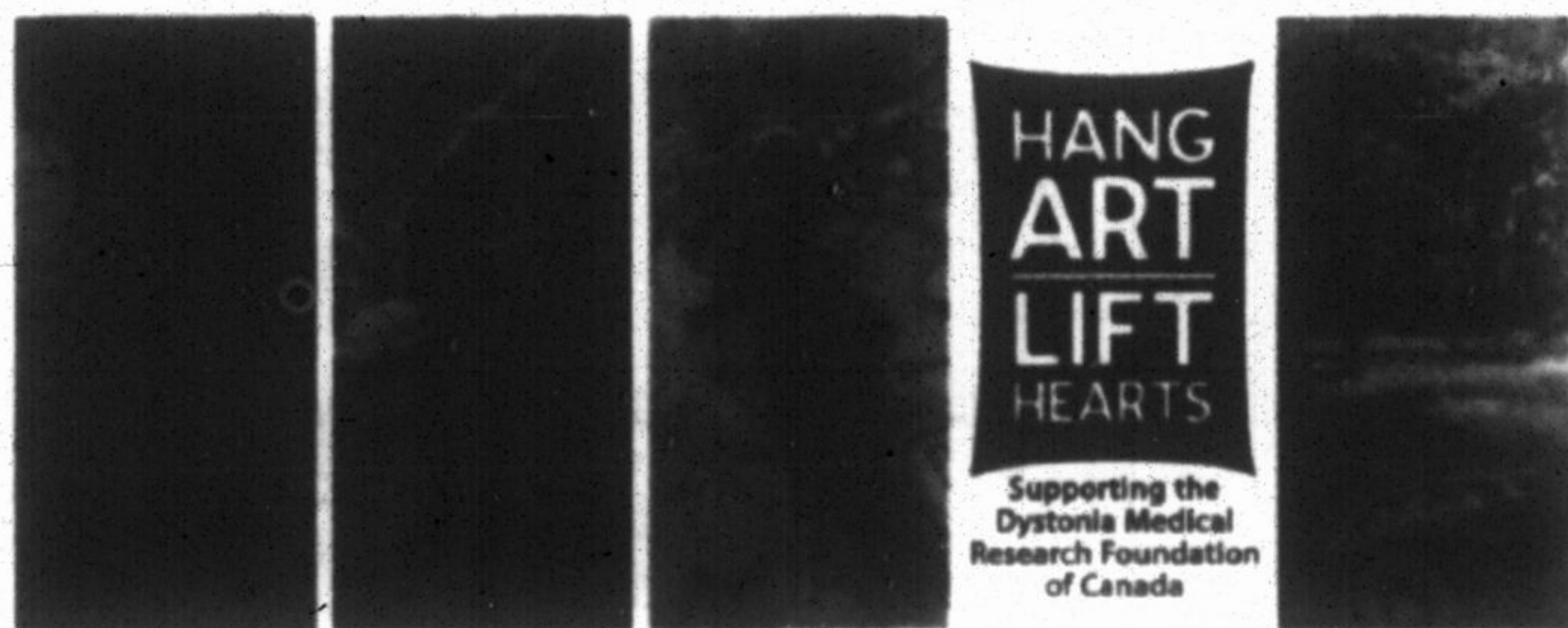
