They are available at the deli counter either a rack or in chops ready to go. When you get them, they are fully

cooked already. Just warm them at a low temperature. A great side to serve them with is our Scalloped Potatoes. Reg. \$1.69/100g


1 ~ CALIFORNIA ~ DIRAWBERIES

This week's deal in our produce department is di California strawberries. They come in a "clamshell" which is equivalent to a quart. A little maple syrup drizzled on these will bring out their best.

These are a good oven roast to have if you like a leaner cut which is still quite tender. They are also great to cube up for use in chili or stews. Reg. \$8.95 lb.

We've got a nice size shipment of Halibut. We debone the fish and sell them in fillet chunks, something a little easier for you to work with, and there's no waste at all! I was looking through the James Beard Cookbook, but all the recipes are for halibut steaks, something that we don't do. What I would suggest is a simple seasoning and right onto the grill, being careful to handle them with a spatula rather than tongs. To be sure you don't overcook them, have a fork handy and part the flake of the flesh a bit. When it is the same colour all the way through, it's done. Wine? Chardonnay or Fumé Blanc, just so you know.
