Young Spartans in rebuild mode

Adding to that challenge will be the absence of a go-to player, a luxury the Spartans had in the past years with future collegians and national level players including Hayley Hughes, her sister Heather Hughes and Liz Knox.

The Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans girls' ice hockey team is on a youth movement this season.

On the surface, it might not be an ideal to be shooting for the York Region Athletic Association tier two title.

But in directing a 16-skater roster comprised of eight rookies, Spartans head coach Brian Shankman hopes the exuberance as exhibited by his charges will help them be a contender within the eight-team circuit.

"Because we have a lot of new players we have to learn to play together and see how quick they can pick things up," he explained. "If we can learn how to play smart I think we'll be all right."

Adding to that challenge will be the absence of a go-to player, a luxury the Spartans had in the past years with future collegians and national level players including Hayley Hughes, her sister Heather Hughes and Liz Knox.

Some of those teams won Ontario championships.

"Even some seniors that graduated last year, like Suzanne Dickie or Vanessa Spitaro or Lindsay Burrows, will be hard to replace," he said. "We definitely won't be relying on one or two players."

Rather, Shankman said they will require

a total team effort.

Among those who Shankman hopes can step up to fill the void include Grade 12 team captain and forward Brittany Leonard along with other forwards Ellen Brown, Abbie Bauman and Sarah Story.

On defence, the Spartans hope Laura Monk can make a quick recovery from a broken hand along with Randi Burke, who is also on the injured list. The blue-line received some help with the presence of Mackenzie Harrington, who transferred from Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville.

The Spartans have three netminders including Grade 9 student Robyn McFee, Grade 12 returnee Megan Nash and Amanda Romano, a Grade 10 student.

While the Spartans won their season-opening game over Alexander Mackenzie (Richmond Hill) by a 1-0 forfeit Monday at the Clippers Sports Complex, their next league game won't take place until Dec. 5 when they host Huron Heights (Newmarket) at the Clippers rink at 3 p.m.

In the meantime, Shankman hopes his youthful charges will continue to pick up the nuances of the game and take the steps required to be a contender this year.

"We'll have fun and I think we should be in the mix. It's where you finish at the end that counts," he said.
