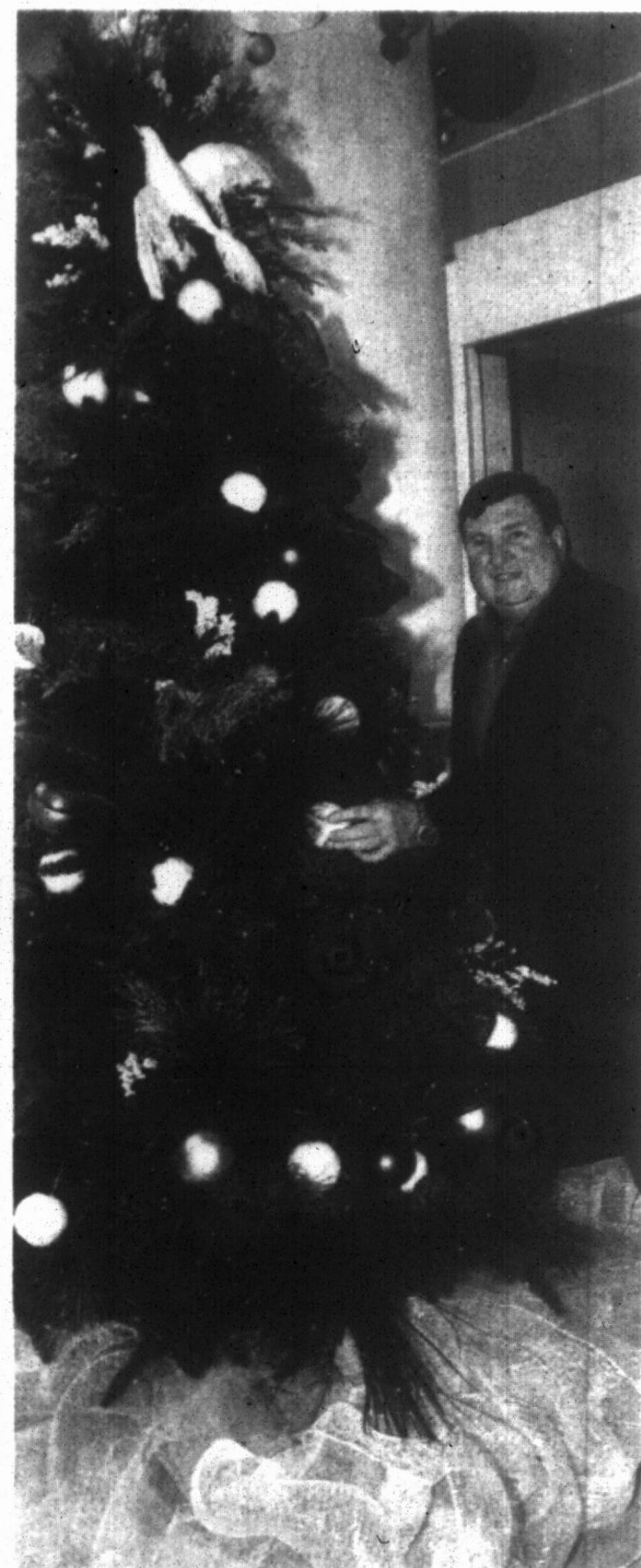

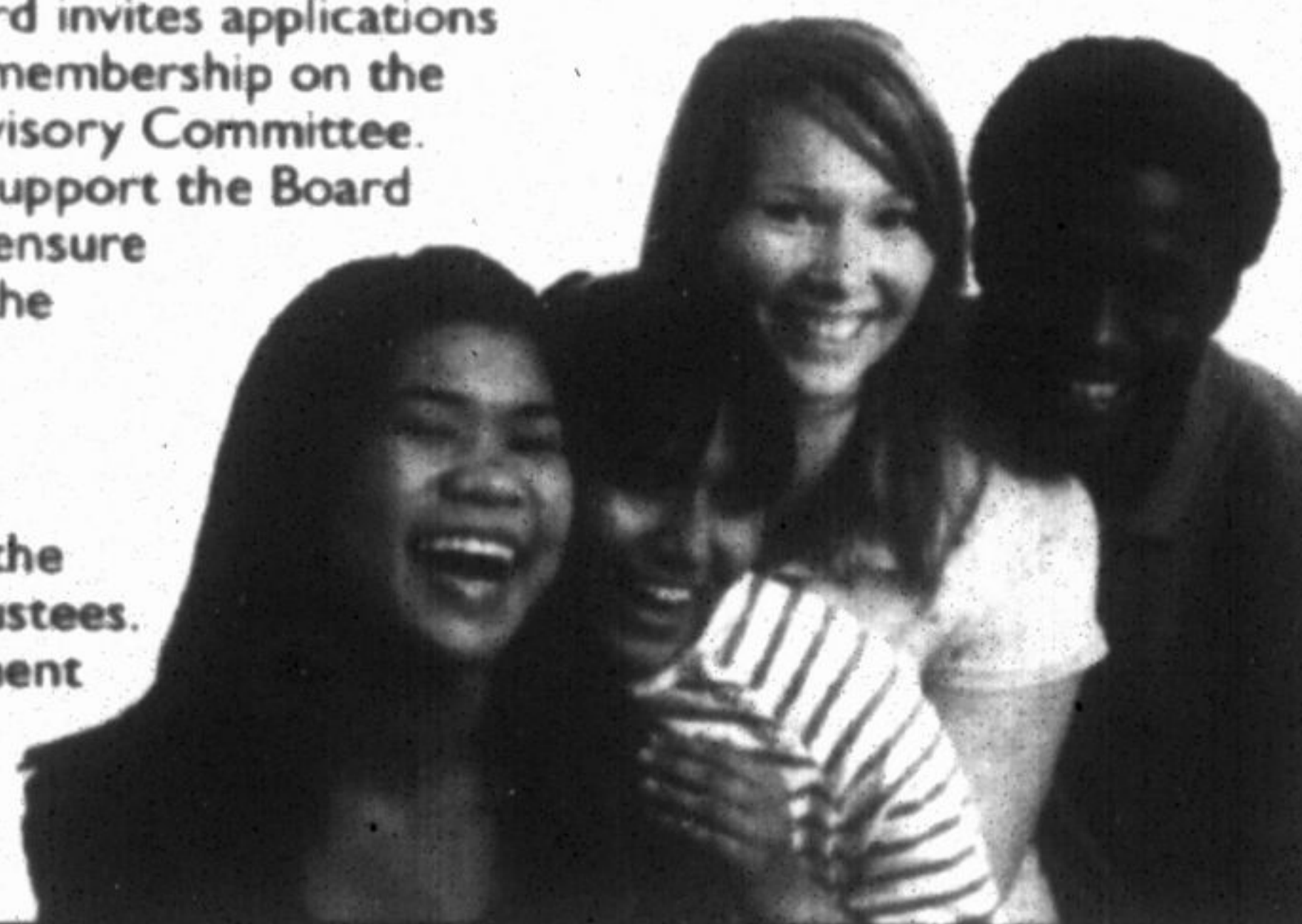


Committed to Equity in Education?
