## Trivino's arrest rocks Spirit ownership

News of the arrest of a former Stouffville Spirit hockey player has left the team's management in disbelief.

Spirit co-owner Zeev Werek expressed shock after hearing Corey Trivino was arrested and charged following an incident in Boston, Mass., last weekend.

Trivino is charged with indecent assault and battery, break and enter in the nighttime and assault with attempt to rape.

The former Stouffville Spirit forward was kicked off the Boston University men's hockey team, a report in BU Today, a student newspaper at the school, reported Tuesday.

## No-show turns into charity gain

The night before the Kinsman Santa Claus parade was to take place, one of its major bands pulled out.

Parade organizers were concerned the absence of the Blue Saints band would affect the Stouffville tradition adversely.

But since there was nothing they could do just hours from the start of the parade, the Kinsmen decided to focus on what they could do with the money they had, since they didn't have to pay the band.

The Kinsmen chose to assist York Region Media Group's annual Santa Fund, which supports about 50 families and works with a number of organizations to ensure each family is able to celebrate Christmas.

"(Our) club mandate is to support the needs in the community," parade co-chairperson Bruce Smith said. "The parade is not designed as a fundraiser. The parade is a community event we do."

The Kinsmen also sponsored a single mother who only asked for her children to receive the necessities such as coats, hats, mitts and pyjamas.

Last week, the Kinettes headed to Giant Tiger and filled two shopping carts full of items.

"They've been very supportive, very helpful," Mr. Smith said of the retailer.
