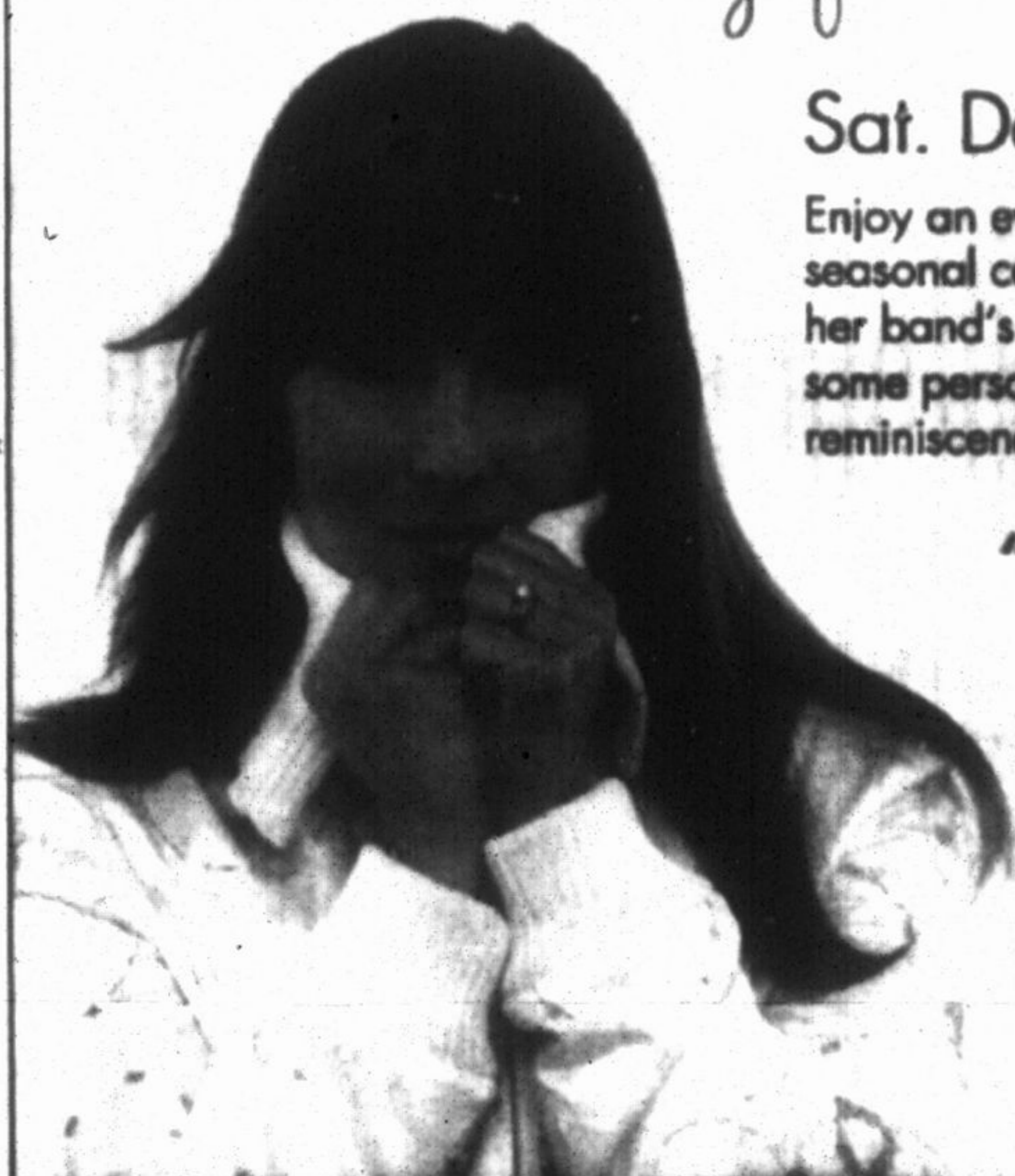

Accused in officer's death gets bail

The youth charged in the death of York Regional Police Const. Garrett Styles has been released on bail, York Region Media Group has learned.

The 15-year-old youth, who is charged with first-degree murder, was granted bail Nov. 28, according to a source close to the case.

The details of the hearing cannot be reported due to a publication ban.

The youth's lawyer, David Berg, filed paperwork in late October that will allow him to represent his client — who he said will never again have use of his limbs — without the youth appearing at the courthouse.

Const. Styles stopped a 2005 Dodge Cara-

van minivan just before 5 a.m. June 28 on Hwy. 48, just south of Herald Road.

Four people, including the male youth, who cannot be identified under the Youth Criminal Justice Act, were in the vehicle, police said.

During the incident, Const. Styles was dragged about 300 metres before the driver lost control and rolled the minivan, pinning the officer.

East Gwillimbury firefighters freed Const. Styles and he was rushed to Southlake Regional Health Centre, where he died.

The youth intends to plead not guilty, Mr. Berg said.

The Crown wants the youth sentenced as an adult if convicted. If this occurs, he would face life in prison. The case returns to the Newmarket courthouse Feb. 8.

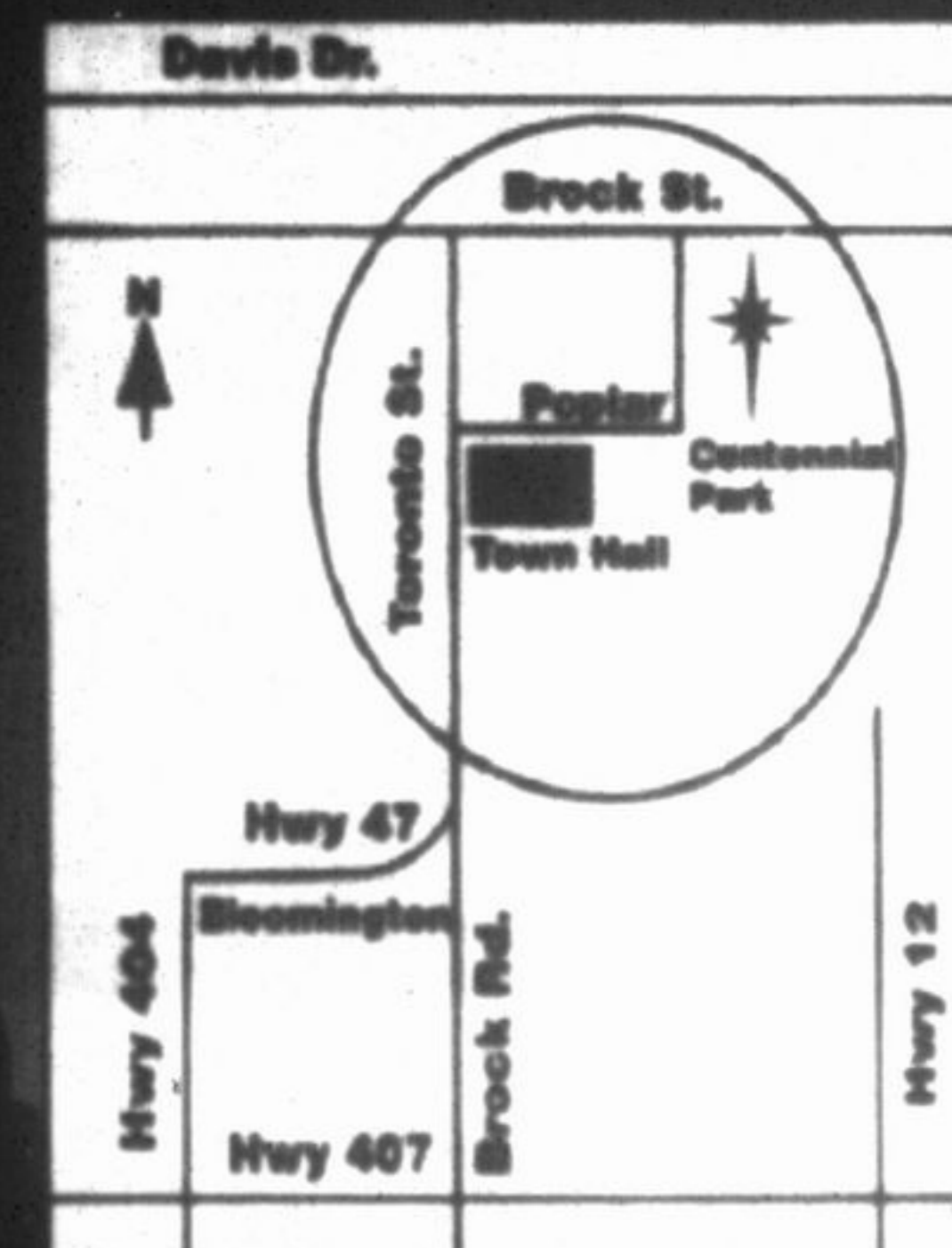
