Food Bank at Christmas, according to Mr. Smith.

But this year, he said, the Kinsmen weren't sure if they could even do that because their major fundraiser at the Markham Fair did not take place.

The band's cancellation, however, not only helped the Santa Fund, but also allowed the Kinsmen to assist Yellow Brick House and the Whitchurch-Stouffville Food Bank,

Mr. Smith said.

Although this year's Santa Fund is over, donations will still be accepted, Stouffville Sun-Tribune's Mike Banville said.

"We have just finished up this year's drive. We continue to take any last minute families in need and can always use gift cards and cash donations which help to fill the gaps."




