

# Baseball bat, pipe entered as evidence at murder trial

displaying and detailing the items for the six-man, six-woman jury.

Clothing retrieved from Mr. Kenyon at York Central Hospital, where he was brought after being discovered at 6 Doner St., included a pair of Adidas sneakers, track pants and a windbreaker. Det. Sgt. Eagan provided opinion, including the suspicion that the shoes may have traces of blood.

The clothing items, save for a pair of underwear belonging to Mr. Kenyon, were on loan from a Doner

Street neighbour, court heard.

The street runs south of Stouffville Road, between Hwy. 404 and Woodbine Avenue.

In exact and measured tones, the officer provided an account of photographs and items prior to each being entered into evidence by Justice Guy DiIomasso. The evidence, court heard, had been analyzed by the Centre For Forensic Science in Toronto.

Court video monitors displayed photographs of the fire-damaged home where Whitchurch-Stouffville firefighter Don McClean discovered Ms Deacon, 46, dead

and apparently beaten. The mother of three daughters was still wearing her coat and waitress uniform from the night before.

The officer displayed images of a red baseball bat discovered inside the home's front entrance. Swabs were taken from the bat when it appeared "biological matter" that "could be dried blood and a fine hair" were on the bat, he confirmed.

Also entered into evidence were Ms Deacon's purse and its contents. Contained in the bag recovered from the kitchen were items including bank cards, photographs, receipts, gum, make-up and a "lit-

tle pipe for non-tobacco smoking," Det. Sgt. Eagan explained.

Ms Deacon and Mr. Kenyon were to meet for a heart-to-heart talk the night she was murdered, court heard during the first day of trial.

His lawyer, Ken Murray, told the court Ms Deacon kicked him out after she found his crack pipe. She told him to get clean or their relationship was over.

An autopsy revealed Ms Deacon suffered multiple blunt force injuries to the head.

The trial, scheduled for five weeks, continues.
