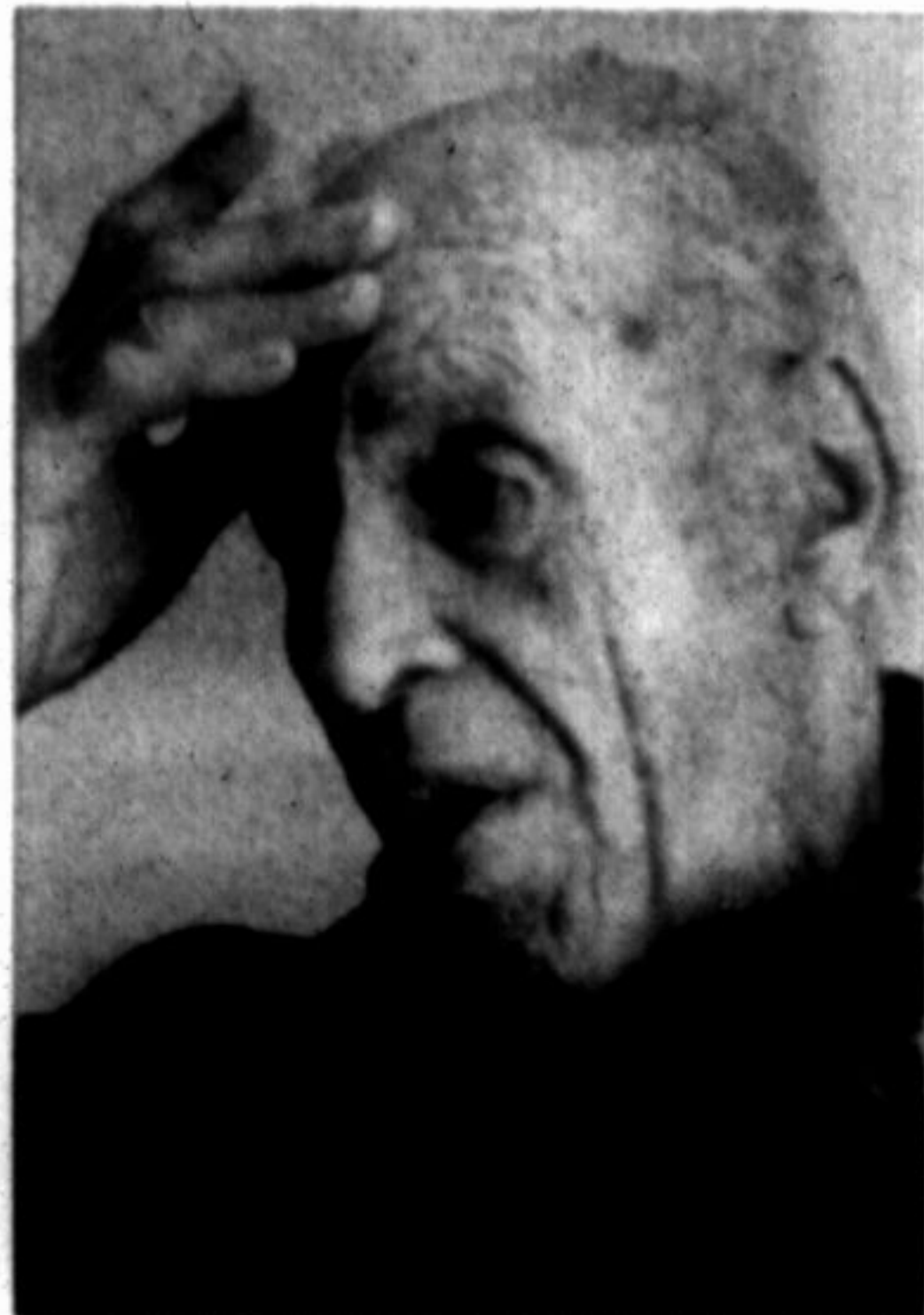


# Concert will aid man who lost house in fire



**HERB BELL:** Stouffville-area senior lost everything in Vandorf Road house fire earlier this month.

A fundraiser Sunday will help a Whitchurch-Stouffville man who lost everything in a fire this month.

The event, in support of Herb Bell, is at the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park and hosted by Al and Trudy Yetman as part of their Gig Centre jam session series.

All money raised through donations will be given to Mr. Bell, who lost his home and all of its contents to fire May 4.

No one was injured.

The event starts at 1 p.m. and

admission, parking and light refreshments are free.

"Not one penny will be deducted from donations for hall rental including overtime rental if that happens to accommodate the long list of musicians expected," Mr. Yetman, a Musselman's Lake resident, said in an e-mail blast.

Mr. Bell's Vandorf Road home burned to the ground.

He lived in the one-and-a-half storey, 2,600-square-foot home for 38 years.

Mr. Yetman's appeal spoke of Mr. Bell's predicament:

"Now picture this. You are a farmer. You arrive home at night after attending a music function and find your home and barn is burnt to the ground.

*'Instantly, he had no clothes, no bed, no phone, no insurance papers, no personal items etc.'*

"Mr. Bell is a good guy, community minded and a member of several community music choral groups."

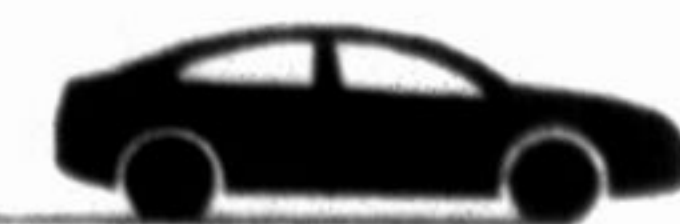
