Musselman's or Musselman Lake?

Is it Musselman Lake or Musselman's Lake?

Whitchurch-Stouffville council is expected to make a decision on the name of the Ninth Line community Tuesday afternoon.

The naming conundrum came about as the public works department is getting ready to replace the hamlet's signs as part of the municipality's corporate branding project.

The area's four current signs indicate the community name is Musselman Lake. But they have all

been defaced with the letter S at the end of Musselman.

SURVEY SAYS...

In 2007, the town and region worked together on new signage for the area to draw attention to the community. After researching the area's first families, it was concluded the community and body of water were both named Musselman Lake, according to a report coming to council.

The province's Ministry of Transportation refers to the vil-

lage as Musselman's Lake, while the Ministry of Natural Resources identifies the water as Musselman's Lake, however, Google maps indicates the village is Musselman's Lake, while the water is Musselman Lake.

A recent survey conducted by the Musselman's Lake Residents Association indicated 81 per cent of those polled prefer Musselman's Lake.

Staff are recommending council approve Musselman's Lake.

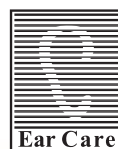
