

Mennos downed in Meaford tourney semis

The Stouffville Mennos advanced to the A Division semifinals at the Tom Sims Memorial Fastball Tournament before they were eliminated by Dundalk 7-1 in a mercy short ended game in Meaford Sunday.

The Mennos drew first blood in the contest when Shawn Boadway hit an inside-the-park home run in the fourth inning.

But that would be the last hurrah as Dundalk erupted with seven runs in their half of the frame.

The Mennos had one last crack at the plate in the fifth inning but could generate no offence before the game concluded.

Greg Dalgarno was the starting pitcher for the Mennos and took the loss.

After being victimized by a no-hit pitching performance by pick-up Andy Jackson in a 1-0 loss to the Tara Merchants Friday, the Mennos rebounded the following day to blank the Mississauga All-Stars 3-0.

Jay Nesbitt struck out 14 batters in earn-

ing the win.

Rick Burkholder ignited the Mennos' offence with two hits.

Later that day, the Mennos had an easy time of things in a 20-0 win over a local rec league team. Byron Baraneski was the winning pitcher.

With three teams, including the Mennos, sporting 2-1 records and with each of the clubs 1-1 in head-to-head play, the Mennos advanced to the semifinals based on a run-differential tiebreaker.

The Mennos resume league play tonight when they host Sharon's Lake Simcoe Lightning at Memorial Park at 8:30 p.m.

In the overall competition, Steinberg finished in a two-way tie in 75th place.
