### DID YOU KNOW? ... THE BROWN HOUSE...

...was built by James Brown between 1850 & 1860  
...has unique features such as built-in bedroom closets & an exterior exit door in the dining room  
...is significant in Stouffville's history – the papers that incorporated Stouffville as its own village were signed in the dining room in 1877  
...was originally located behind the Stouffville Flea Market  
...was donated to the Museum in 1984 by a developer & took 7 years to restore  
...is restored to represent a typical farmhouse of the 1880s
