YARD WASTE/LEAF COLLECTION

Residents are advised that leaves will only be collected if they are in paper bags or reusable open top containers (excluding cardboard boxes) such as bushel baskets or garbage cans. Plastic bags will not be collected.

The Town does not pick up leaves raked, blown or piled along the roads. Non-containerized or non-bagged leaves present a traffic and drainage hazard and residents are required to remove them.

Yard Waste should be placed curbside for collection by 7:00 am on the collection day.

Other materials accepted for collection include leaves, plants, fine brush, tree clippings and branches up to 100 mm (4") in diameter

and tied in bundles of a maximum length of 1.2 metres (4') and weighing no more than 22 kgs (50 lbs).
