Items to create make-up kits are being collected at the Whitchurch-Stouffville Leisure Centre until Nov. 15.

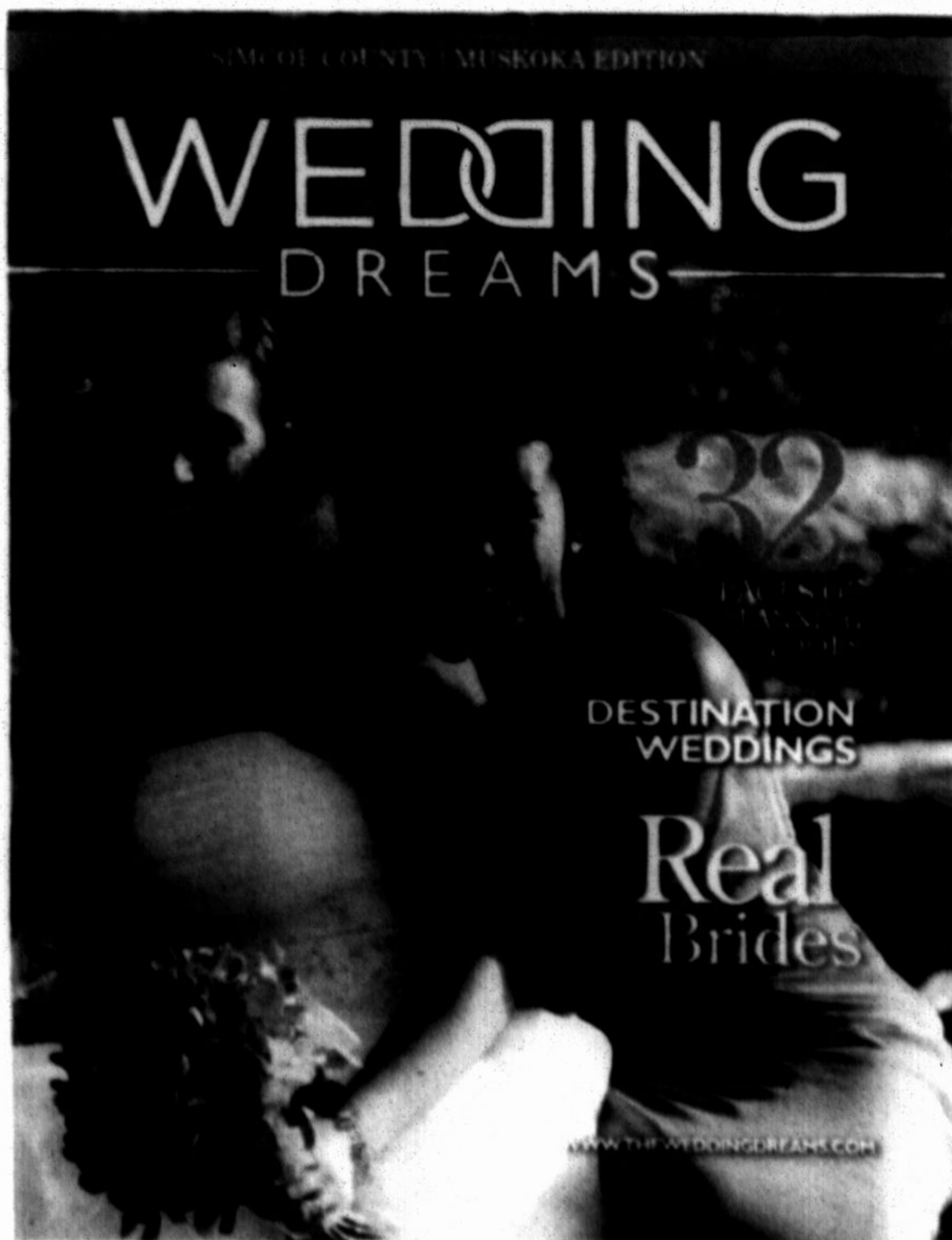
