

Pedestrian Trail Bridge Crossing of Little Rouge Creek Class Environmental Assessment Study



THE STUDY

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, through their engineering consultant Chisholm. Fleming and Associates, has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment for a proposed pedestrian trail bridge crossing of the Little Rouge Creek. The proposed bridge would connect to existing recreation trails and provide continuity to the overall trail network, as identified in the Town's trail plan.

THE PROCESS

This project is being planned as a Schedule 'B' project as outlined in the Municipal Engineer's Association (MEA) Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007 & 2011), which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act.

A key component of the study will be consultation with interested stakeholders (public and agencies). One Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held as part of the consultation process, at which the project and scope will be presented, alternative solutions and evaluation criteria reviewed, and environmental impacts and mitigation measures discussed.

The PIC will be held November 28, 2012 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with a brief presentation at 7:00 p.m. The venue will be the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Municipal Offices at 111 Sandiford Drive, in the Council Chambers.




